What's Next?

Soon after you submit your online application, you will receive an automatic email from CoCoRaHS containing your login and temporary password. At this point you should log in and change your password to something easy for you to remember.

Within a day or two of joining, you should also receive a welcome email from your local coordinator which should include a copy of the New York or western New England CoCoRaHS Observer's Guide.

Once we have determined what we think is your correct latitude/longitude, you will receive an email with the subject line similar to "Your location for CoCoRaHS NY-**CO-nn**", where **CO** is the county abbreviation and **nn** is your station number. Follow the instructions in the message.

Once your location is verified, a name will be generated for your station. You will then receive the official "Welcome New York CoCoRaHS Volunteer" email. This will contain your station number, station name, and the name of your local coordinator(s). Follow the instructions in the email to confirm or correct the information in the email.

Once you have your login and password, and your rain gauge installed, you may start reporting!
