THE ICE STORM YESTERDAY WILL CONTINUE TO HAVE AN IMPACT ON THE
AREA FROM THE SOUTHERN ADIRONDACKS TO SOUTHERN VERMONT THIS
MORNING. HEAVY ICE CLINGING TO TREES AND POWER LINES IN SOME
LOCATIONS MAY PRODUCE ADDITIONAL PROBLEMS THIS MORNING. FIFTEEN TO 25
MILE AN HOUR NORTHERLY WINDS WILL PUT AN ADDITIONAL STRAIN ON THESE
SUPPORTING STRUCTURES.

AS A RESULT...POWER OUTAGES MAY CONTINUE TO OCCUR THIS MORNING DUE TO
LIMBS OR TREES FALLING ON POWER LINES. ALSO...UNTREATED ROADS AND
WALKWAYS WILL BE HAZARDOUS TO DRIVE OR WALK UPON. IN
ADDITION...IF WALKING UNDER STRUCTURES CONTAINING ICE KEEP A
WARY EYE ABOVE YOU. LARGE CHUNKS OF FALLING ICE CAN CAUSE SERIOUS
INJURY OR EVEN DEATH.
