THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN ALBANY NEW YORK PERFORMED A STORM SURVEY IN WOODBURY CONNECTICUT ON JUNE 13 2011. MOST OF THE DAMAGE WAS TO HARDWOOD TREES AND WAS CONSISTENT WITH A MICROBURST WITH WINDS MOVING FROM SOUTHWEST TO NORTHEAST. THE AREA OF DAMAGE WAS APPROXIMATELY ONE MILE WIDE BY ONE AND A HALF MILES LONG. THE AREA OF DAMAGE WAS BOUNDED ROUGHLY BY UPPER GRASSY HILL ROAD AND GREAT HOLLOW ROAD. EYEWITNESS VIDEO AND PHOTOS INDICATED A FUNNEL CLOUD MOVED OVER THE DAMAGE AREA. THE GROUND SURVEY INDICATED A BRIEF TOUCHDOWN OF A TORNADO AT 140 GREAT HOLLOW ROAD.
