SUNDAY AFTERNOON A TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN NEAR THE TOWN OF FLORIDA IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY. IT MOVED NORTHEAST TO THE WESTERN END OF GLENVILLE IN SCHENECTADY COUNTY. THE DAMAGE PATH WAS APPROXIMATELY HALF A MILE WIDE AND ABOUT 7 MILES LONG. DAMAGE WAS EXTENSIVE ALONG THE ENTIRE PATH LENGTH...WITH THE WORST DAMAGE IN THE TOWN OF CRANESVILLE.
