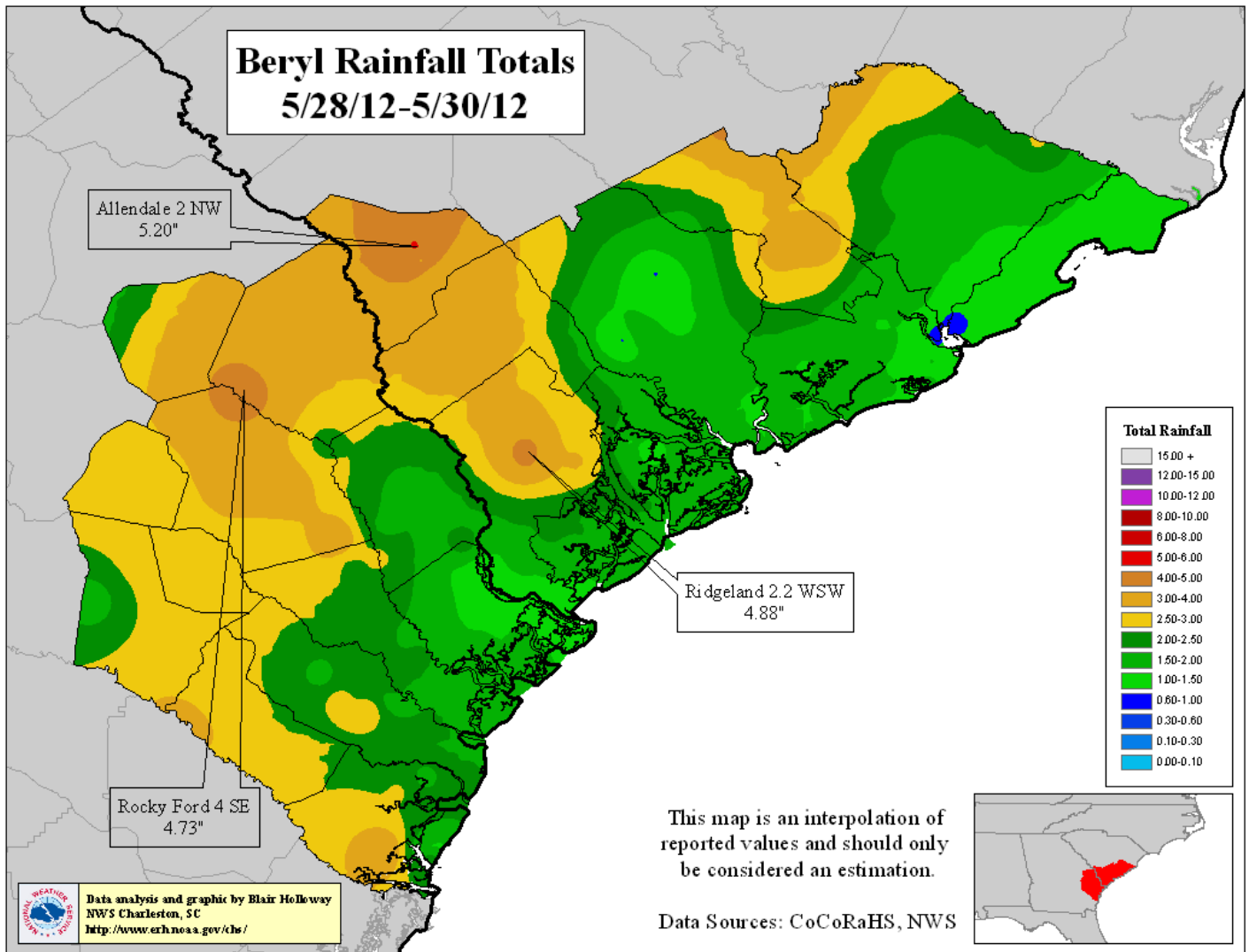

REMARKS: THE HEAVIEST RAINFALL OCCURRED AFTER THE BERYL MOVED INLAND AND BECAME A TROPICAL DEPRESSION. RADAR ESTIMATES OF RAINFALL BETWEEN 5/29 AND 5/30 SHOW THAT JENKINS COUNTY...GEORGIA RECEIVED UP TO 5 TO 7 INCHES OF RAINFALL WITH LOCALLY HIGHER AMOUNTS POSSIBLE. A LARGER SWATH OF HEAVY RAINFALL WAS SHOWN BY RADAR AND SUPPORTED BY REPORTS OVER CENTRAL AND NORTHERN DORCHESTER COUNTY...SOUTH CAROLINA...WHERE 3 TO 5 INCHES OF RAINFALL FELL. FINALLY...A SMALLER AREA OF HEAVY RAINFALL WAS SHOWN BY RADAR AND SUPPORTED BY REPORTS OVER NORTH CENTRAL JASPER COUNTY...SOUTH CAROLINA.

D. INLAND FLOODING...

JENKINS...WATER 3 FOOT ACROSS STATE ROAD 17 IN HERNDON. ADDITIONAL FLOODING ON 17 NEAR BIRDSVILLE ROAD.

CHARLESTON...ASHLEY AVENUE BETWEEN SUMTER STREET AND RACE STREET FLOODED AND IMPASSABLE.

DORCHESTER...WATER FLOODED INTO A RESIDENCE AT 129 BOWMAN STREET.

REMARKS: SINCE MAXIMUM STORM SURGES DID NOT NECESSARILY COINCIDE WITH THE HIGHEST STORM TIDES...THE DATES AND TIMES LISTED WERE FOR THE STORM TIDE. THE STORM TIDE VALUES WERE RELATIVE TO MLLW. MODERATE BEACH EROSION WAS REPORTED FOR PORTIONS OF LIBERTY AND MCINTOSH COUNTIES IN GEORGIA.
