



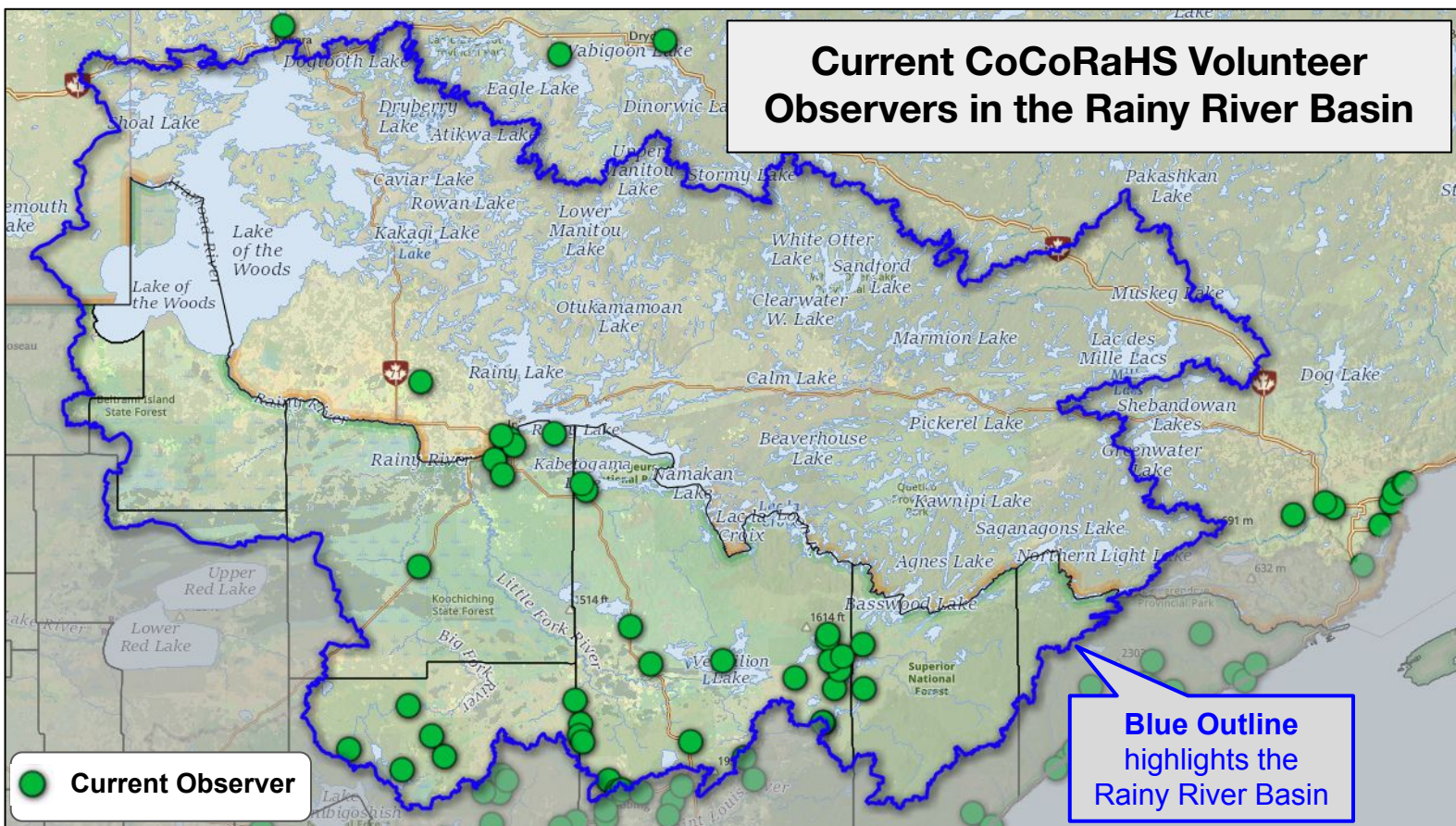
Recruiting Weather Observers



NWS Duluth Seeks CoCoRaHS Volunteers in the Rainy River Basin

CoCoRaHS: Community Collaborative Rain, Hail and Snow Network

→ More ground truth observations across these rural areas will better inform hydrologists and meteorologists come spring flood season.



Interested?

All you need is the official gauge!



1. Sign up at cocorahs.org
2. Purchase an official CoCoRaHS rain gauge (OR, if you just want to report snowfall/snow depth, you just need a good yardstick!)
3. Report your daily rain, snow, and snow depth (snowpack depth) using the CoCoRaHS website or app daily each morning*

**Reporting only when you can such as after major storms is OK, but daily observations are best!*
