### MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR AUGUST 2018


#### ... AUGUST TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

August saw a continuation of near daily thunderstorm activity. Monthly precipitation amounts were highest along and south of the Mogollon Rim with above normal rainfall for Flagstaff and Prescott. Northeastern Arizona was drier than normal, with Window Rock and Show Low receiving less than half the normal August rainfall. Temperatures were warmer than normal across the region.
