February was drier than average for most of northern and central Arizona. The main periods of rain and snow were around the middle of the month and again the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> when heavy snow fall across much of the region, causing significant travel delays and road closures.

Temperatures were well below normal for the month.

A strong wind event occurred on Feb 21.
