...TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW...

The month of June was warmer and drier than normal across northern Arizona. Many areas received no precipitation at all, with spotty light amounts observed toward the end of the month due to some thunderstorm activity. Temperatures were significantly above normal in all areas as strong high pressure persisted for most of the month.
