... JUNE TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

June temperatures were near average across northern Arizona. Most of the region received little or no precipitation for the month, which is not unusual as June is the driest month of the year on average for this area. Small portions of eastern Arizona saw thunderstorms near the end of the month, which brought above normal rain for the month to a few locations including St. Johns and Window Rock.




