

June 2020 Climate Summary



June was characterized by periods of warm and cool weather with very dry conditions. Many areas received only a trace of precipitation or less, with only a few stations along the Eastern Mogollon Rim and White Mountains reporting measurable rain. June saw several windy days, some of which were uncharacteristically windy for this time of year.
