#### MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR MAY 2016


#### ... MAY TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

The month of May brought multiple cold spring storm systems resulting in periods of cool and stormy weather. Overall, temperatures were cooler than average and precipitation was well above normal for one of the historically driest months in northern Arizona. The storm systems brought periods of windy conditions along with some high elevation snowfall.
