

# MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR NOVEMBER 2016

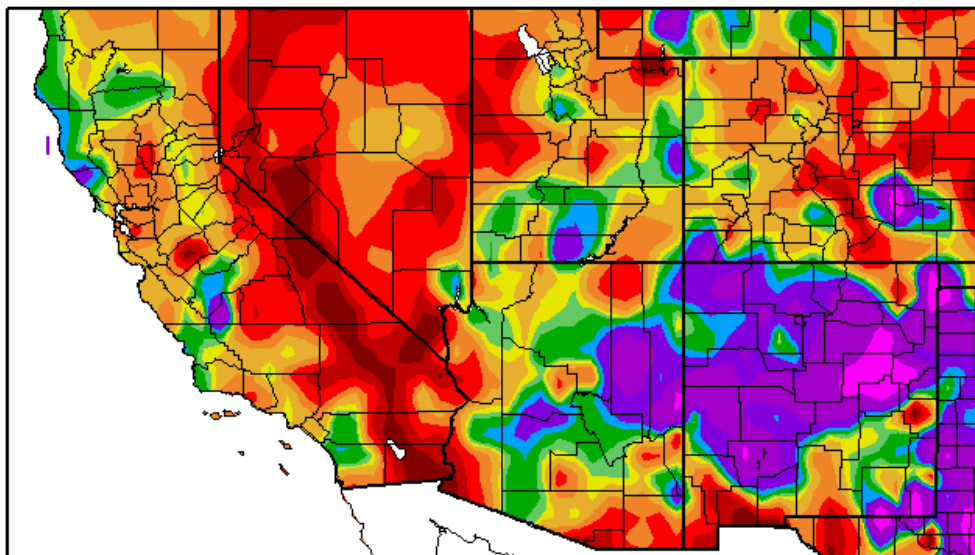
## ... NOVEMBER TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

Overall, much of November experienced well above average temperatures. It wasn't until the last week of the month that colder weather arrived. After a dry October, a few different storm systems brought beneficial rain and high elevation snow to northern Arizona. Nearly all of northern Arizona received above average monthly precipitation.

**Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> Funnel Cloud:** Funnel Cloud reported in Joseph City. [Report Here](#).

**Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Rainfall:** Widespread rain fell across northern Arizona with the heaviest amounts covering a portion of north central Arizona where 1 to 2 inches of rain fell. [Rainfall Reports Here](#).

**Nov. 16<sup>th</sup> Strong Wind:** A passing, dry weather system brought increased wind to northern Arizona. [Wind Reports Here](#).

**Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> Rainfall:** Another round of rain spread across northern Arizona with many areas receiving anywhere from 0.5 inch to 1.5 inches of rain. [Rainfall Reports Here](#).

**Nov. 27<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> High Elevation Snow:** The first significant snow of the season arrived in northern Arizona with several mountainous locations receiving measurable snowfall. [Snowfall Reports Here](#).
