

November 2020 Climate Summary

November 2020 was warmer and much drier than normal for most of northern Arizona. The exception was the White Mountains region where 75-100% of average precipitation fell. Most of the month's precipitation fell in two storms, one on Nov. 8-9 and the other on Nov. 26-27.
