# MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR OCTOBER 2016

### ... OCTOBER TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

October 2016 was among the warmest on record across northern Arizona as high pressure controlled the weather pattern across the region for most of the month. Monthly rainfall amounts were less than half of normal for most of northern Arizona, with a small area near 80 percent of normal in central Yavapai County including Prescott.




