
MONTH IN REVIEW FOR NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR OCTOBER 2019


... OCTOBER TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

October was cooler and much drier than normal across northern and central Arizona. Most locations received little or no precipitation, with this month in the driest 10% of all Octobers on record. A dry air mass that prevailed through the month allowed overnight low temperatures to be much below normal.
