The Manter Wildfire (possible arson cause) in the southernmost part of the Sequoia National Park just above the Kern County line in the Dome Land Wilderness Area burned from July 22nd and was contained on August 10th. It burned 74,010 acres and 16 structures, including at least 7 homes in the Pine Creek area. Its cost of containment was \$11.2 Million and involved 978 personnel.

The Edison wildfire began on July 31st from an unknown cause and was contained the next day (August 1st) after burning 150 acres. No structures were lost and the cost to contain was unreported.
