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Cold frontal passage brought the first significant snows to the upper elevations of the Southern Sierra Nevada and Tulare County Mountains during the 30th. A Winter Storm Watch was posted early on the 28th and resulting snowfall on the 30th provided: 13 inches of snow at Upper Burnt Corral at 9775 feet MSL and Bishop Pass at 11,200' Ft in the South Sierra Nevada; and, 10" at Upper Tyndall Creek at 10,800 Ft in the Tulare County Mountains.
