	A public report provided information that 1-inch hail occurred from a thunderstorm crossing the Tulare-Inyo County line on the 16th. Locally heavy rainfall rates estimated by NWS Radar ranged from 2.5 to 3 inches in an hour over the previously burned Manter Fire area of Tulare and Kern Counties.
