The remaining central California drought areas in Kern County were finally terminated during the month of February, 2017. Bakersfield received slightly above normal precipitation with 1.46" during the month. Above normal precipitation amounts did allow for continued improvement on drought conditions with an increase in soil moisture and further reservoir recharge.

The U.S. Drought Monitor continued to report drought conditions with only a small area in southwestern Kern county having the Extreme (D3) category left along with parts of the Kern County Desert areas. The month ended with no areas of central California Interior with a D3 Extreme drought category.
