## **Heat Advisories Today For North Central FL zones**

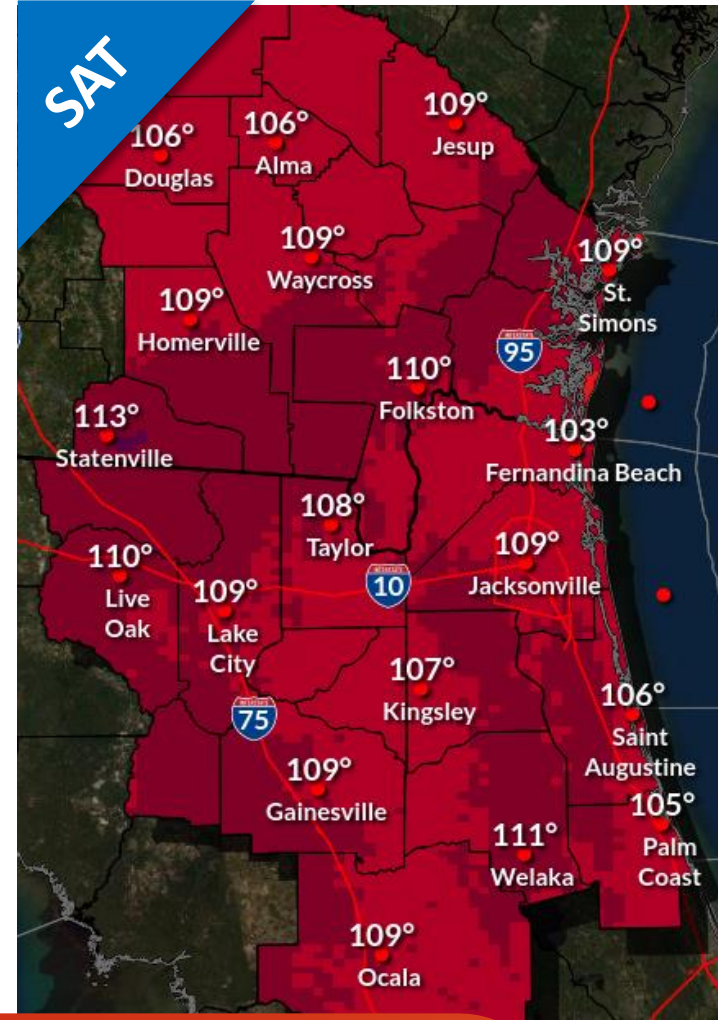
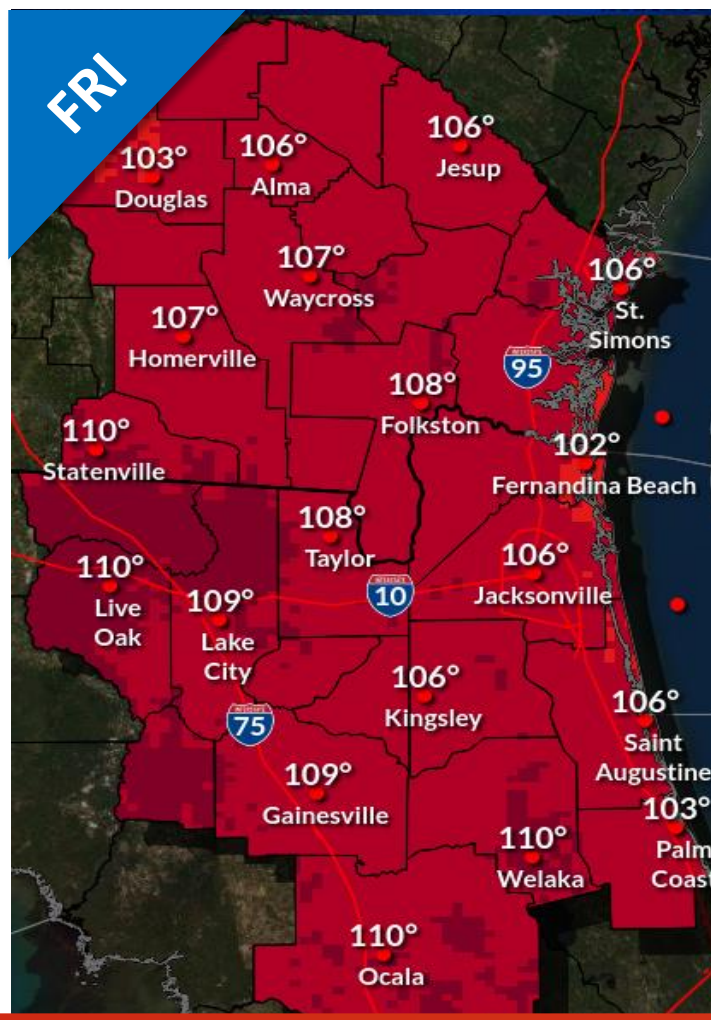
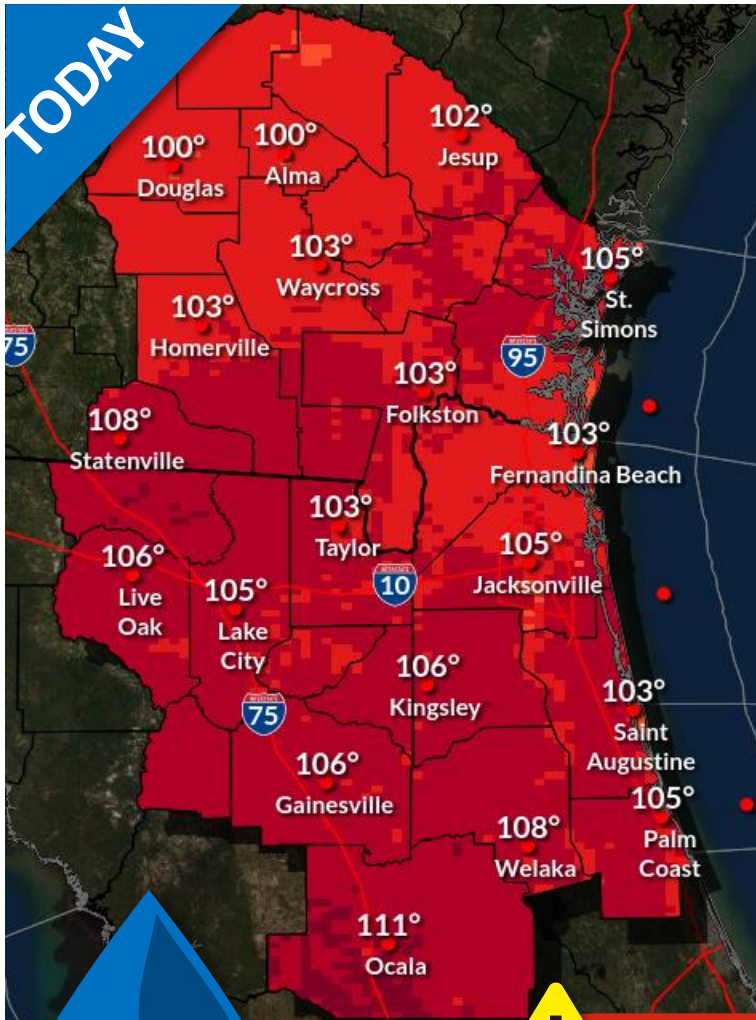
- Heat Indices 108-110

Temperatures will “feel like” they are in the low 100s,





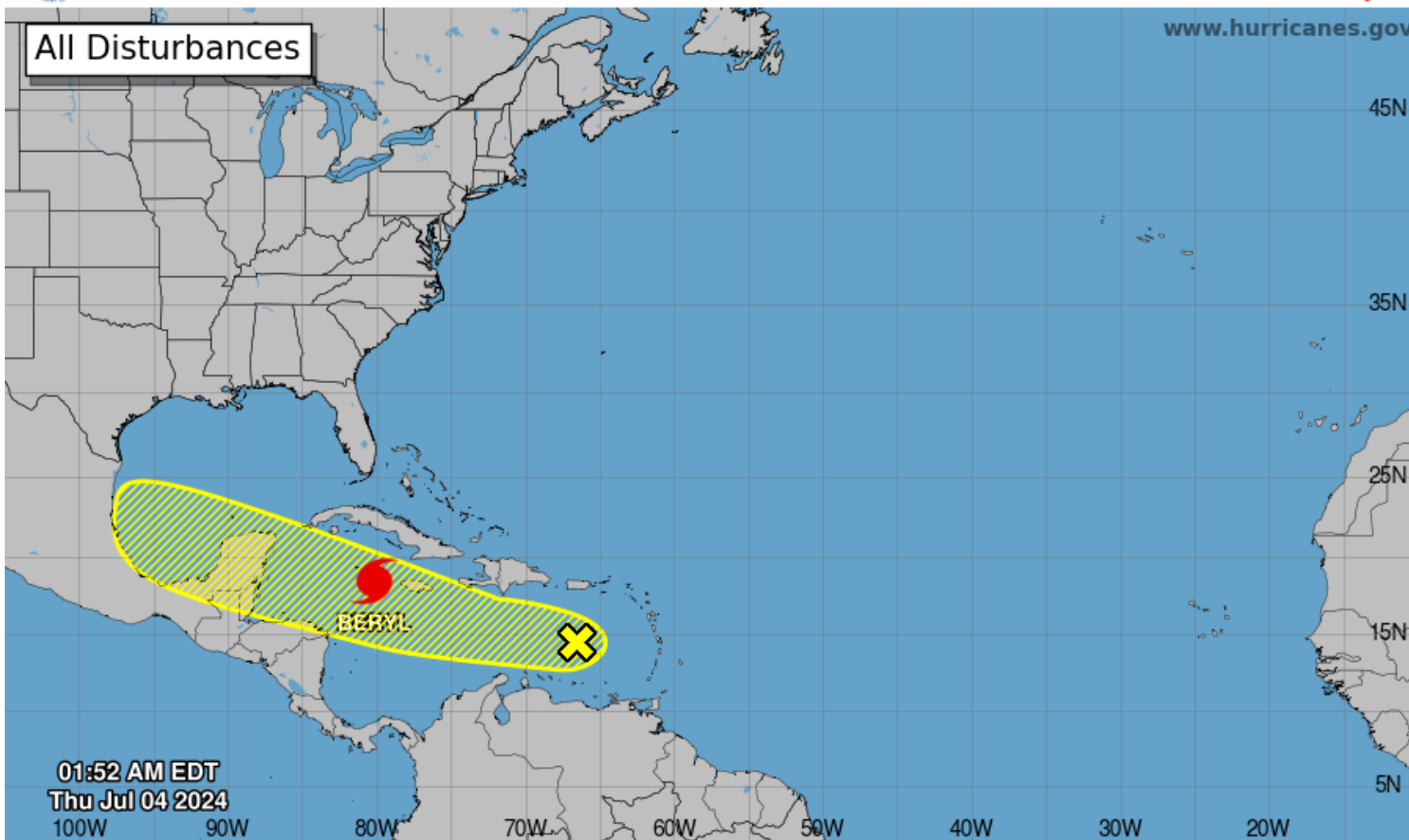
# Tropical Weather Outlook
