TOP STORY:


A progressive pattern will persist through the forecast period, with a series of cold fronts affecting the region first this weekend and then around the middle of next week.

Rainfall in the Past Week




Last weekend's rainfall event brought widespread areas of 1-3in of rain to parts of SE TX, along with localized amounts near 6-8in. Elsewhere, we saw about .5-1in of rain in the last week.



River Forecasts




Most rivers across the region are below flood criteria this week, however, a few points across SE TX/SW LA are near flooding. These include Pine Island Bayou near Sour Lake, TX, Village Creek near Kountze, TX, and Calcasieu River near White Oak Park.



Upper Level Steering Patterns




A large upper ridge resides to our west across the Western CONUS, while to our east a deepening trough is over the Eastern CONUS. The forecast area resides between these two features.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts




Surface high pressure extends from the Rockies to the northwestern Gulf Coast.
Further north, a couple of cold front area noted near the Great Lakes Region as well as over the far northern Rockies.



6 am Weather Observations




A cool and sunny start to the day was seen across the region this morning with temps in the mid-30s to mid-40s amid sunny skies.



2 pm Weather Observations




Still sunny and mild across the area as of 2PM, with temps currently in the upper 60s to low 70s.

Weekly Weather Summary



- Our next frontal system will move through the region on Saturday, bringing a chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms along with a drop in temperatures.
- Temperatures will gradually moderate back into the upper 60s to low 70s through the first half of next week, as high pressure slides across the SEern US.
- After a brief warming trend, another frontal system will move through the region around the Wed-Thu time period, bringing some isolated showers as well as a slight cool down for the second half of the week.
