
A series of disturbances will bring rain chances this weekend and again early next week. Temperatures will be cool, but close to seasonal normal.

Rainfall in the Past Week




Rainfall amounts have been generally around an inch or less the past week. A few spots in southern and central Louisiana saw at least 1.5 inches of rain.



River Forecast




A couple of points on the **lower Sabine River** remain above flood stage. Water levels continue to slowly recede and these sites should fall below flood stage over the next day or two.



Upper Level Steering Patterns




Westerly flow aloft prevails across the area, beneath a large upper level low over the Midwest. Another system is moving into the Intermountain West.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts




There is a cold front over the southeastern US (responsible for the weather here yesterday), with a secondary front northwest of the area that will reinforce the cool and dry weather tonight into Friday.



6 am Weather Observations




Under mostly clear skies, temperatures ranged from the lower/middle 40s to the middle 50s across much of the area. Winds were mostly light, out of the northwest.



2 pm Weather Observations




Temperatures have warmed into the upper 60s to lower 70s under mostly sunny skies. Winds are northwesterly 5 to 10 MPH.



Rest of the Day






Dry conditions are expected, with mild temperatures this afternoon and cool but seasonal temperatures overnight.





Excessive Rainfall Outlook




