# **TOP STORY:**


Freezing temperatures are expected tonight. Any precipitation falling after midnight could be sleet or freezing rain. No accumulation is expected.








### Upper Level Steering Patterns







### Surface Weather Map with Fronts











Patchy light rain is seen by radar near Houston and Galveston, stretching out into the Gulf of Mexico.



# Radar Simulation Tonight into Friday AM






Light rain over Texas moves east this evening and could produce a little sleet or rain in southeast Texas or southwest Louisiana.




### Risk Area for Freezing Rain or Sleet

 Patchy light rain could turn to patchy freezing rain and sleet later tonight, primarily along and south of the I-10 corridor. No ice accumulation is expected.

 Temperatures will be below freezing each night through the weekend. A hard freeze (25 F or below) is expected in most of our region from Friday night into Saturday morning.
