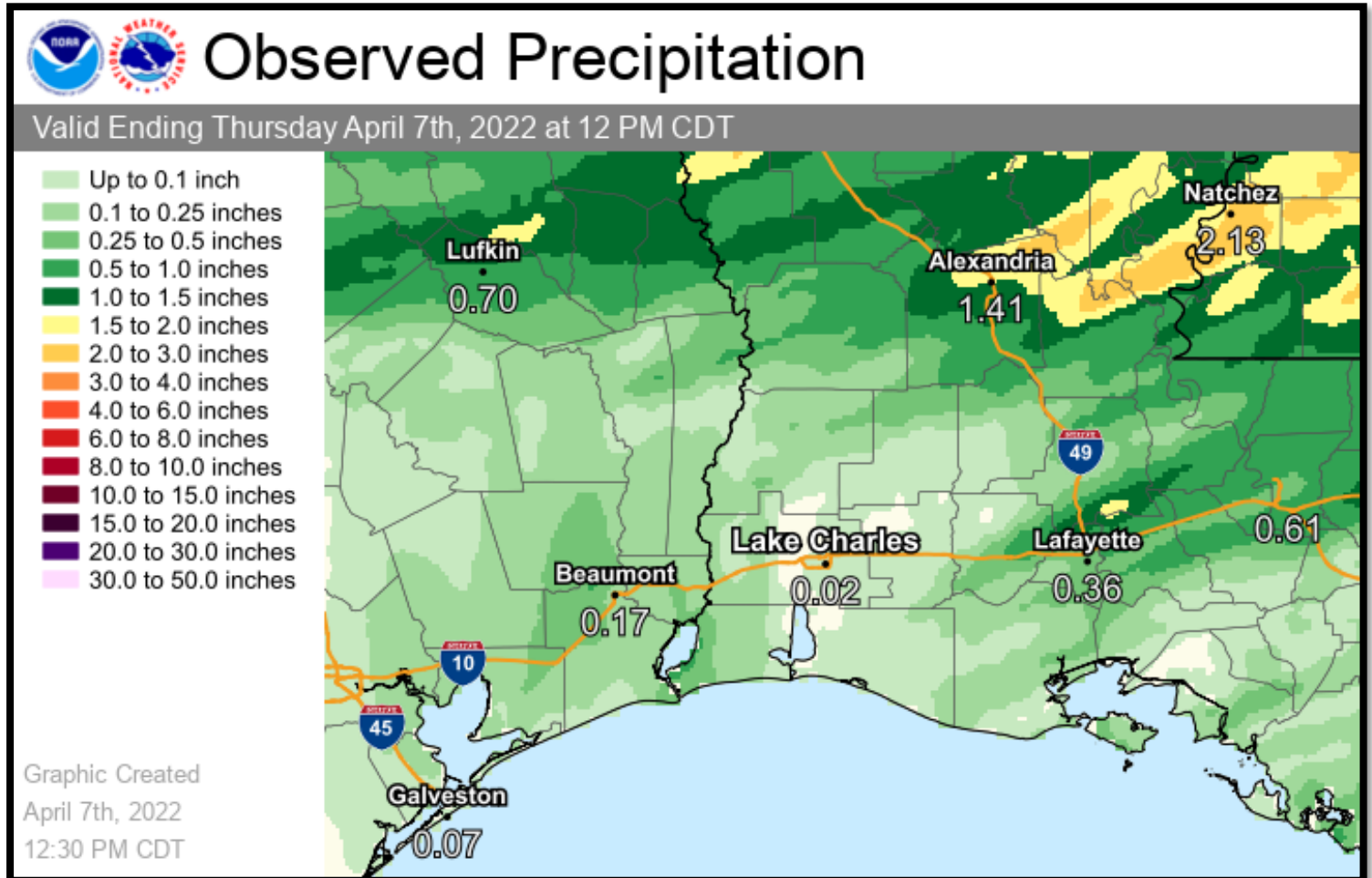
TOP STORY:

Clear and cool into the weekend, but warming up Sunday into next week. Rain chances return next week as disturbances pass aloft.

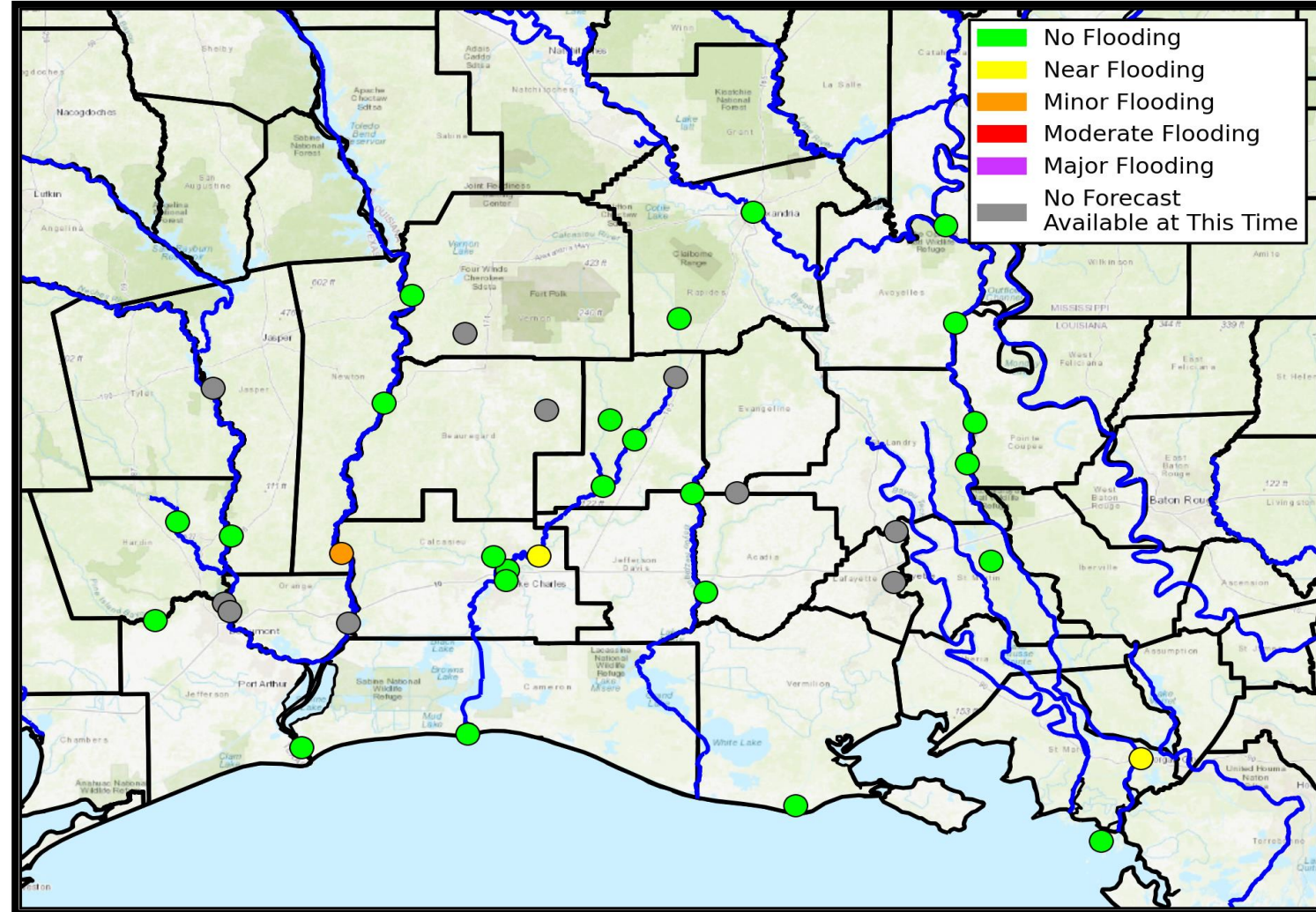

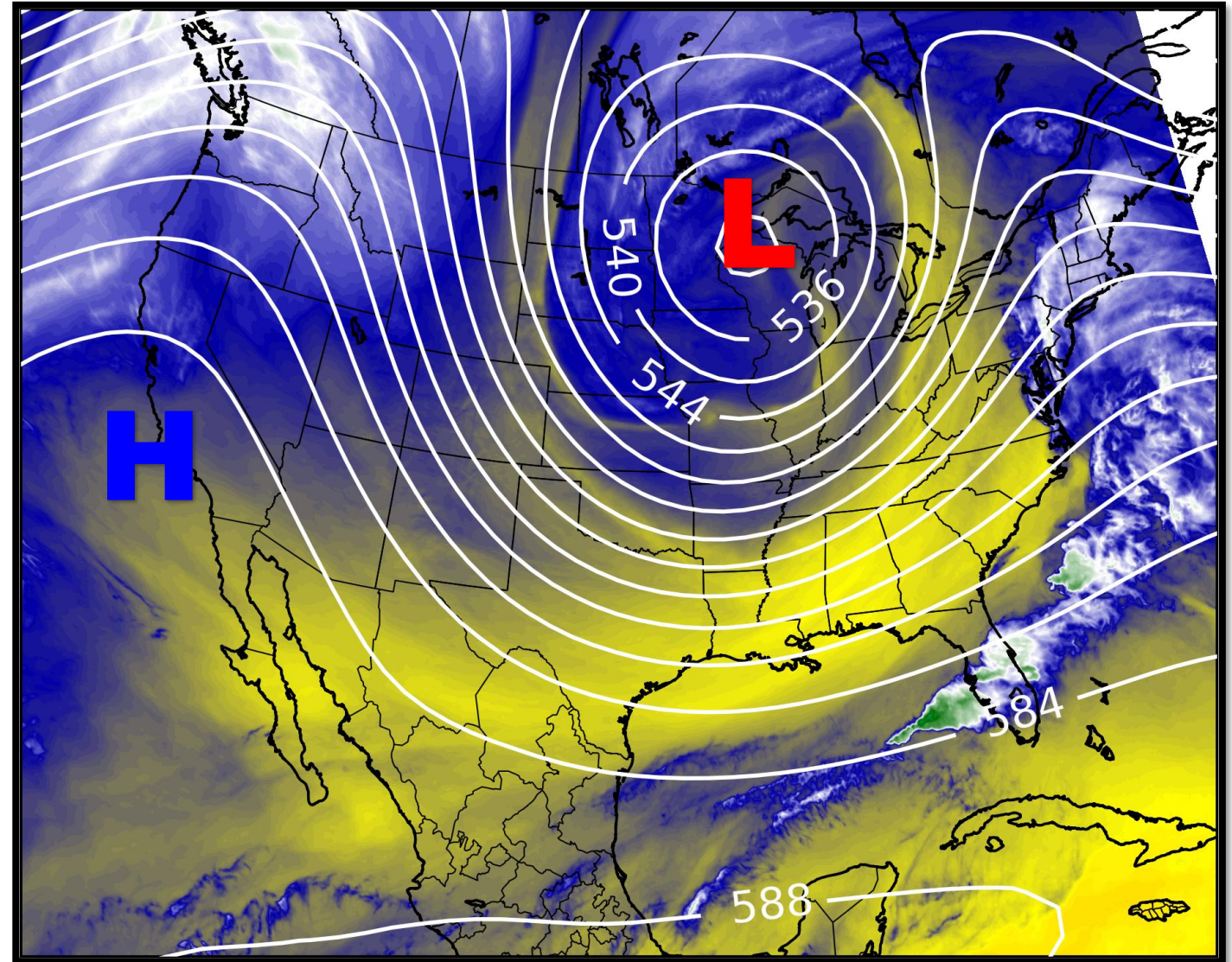


Upper Level Steering Patterns

An upper trough is across most of the country. This is producing a deep north to northwest flow across the central sections of the country and allowing cooler air to the gulf coast.

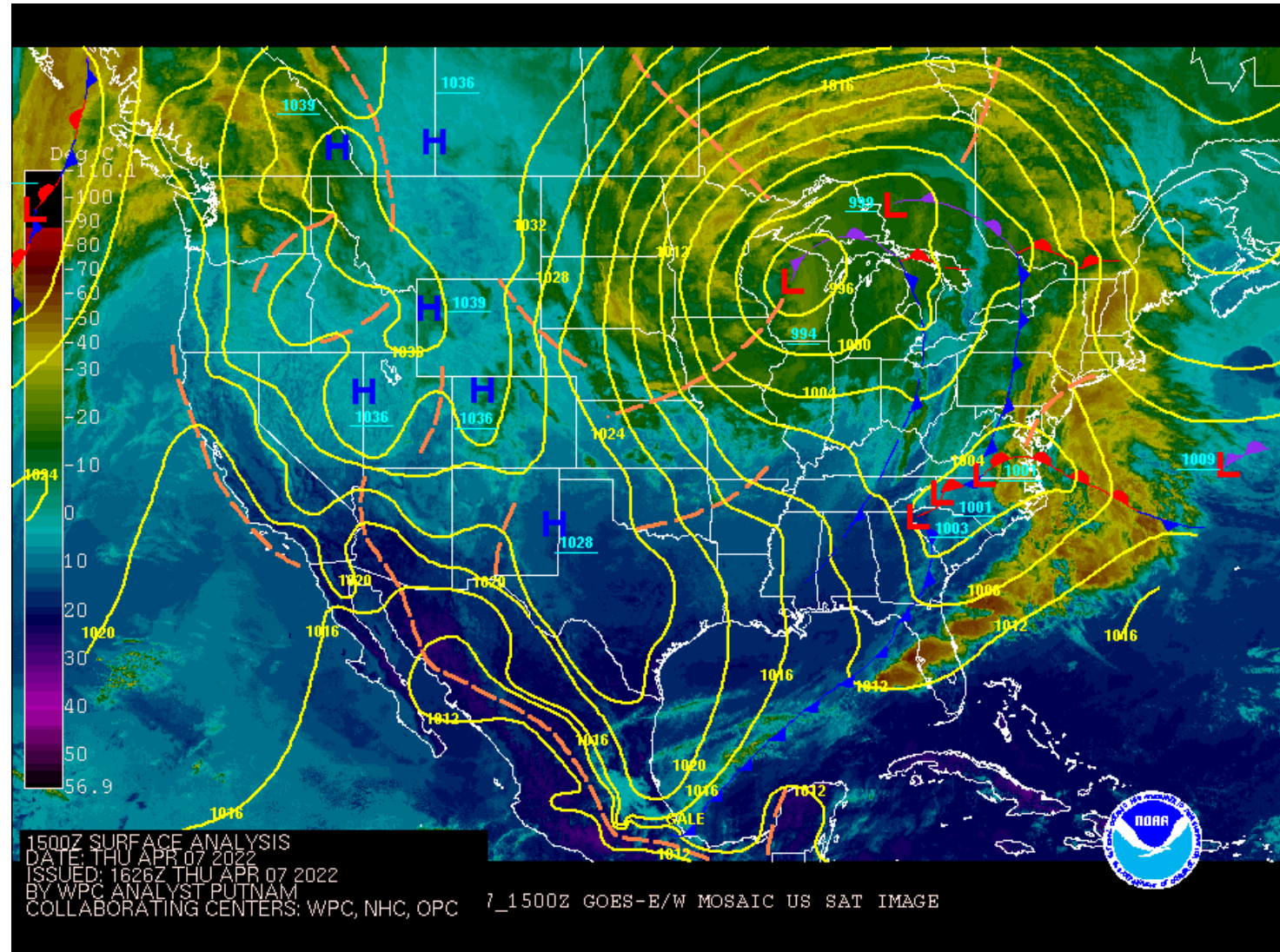


Surface Weather Map with Fronts

Low pressure is located over the Great Lakes Region with high pressure over the plains. The Canadian airmass associated with the ridge has filtered into the local area.



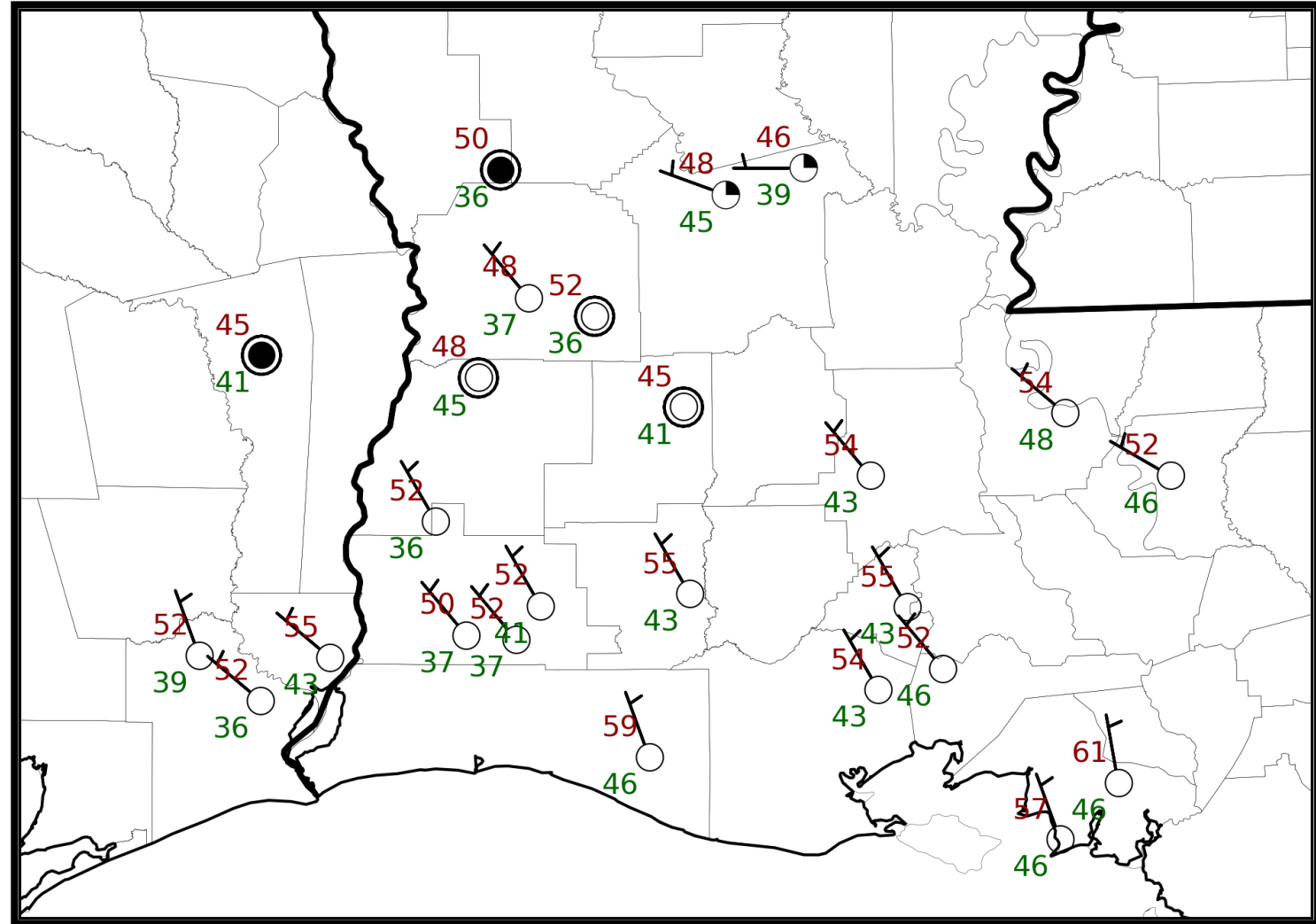
6 am Weather Observations

Average low temperatures for the date are in 50s.

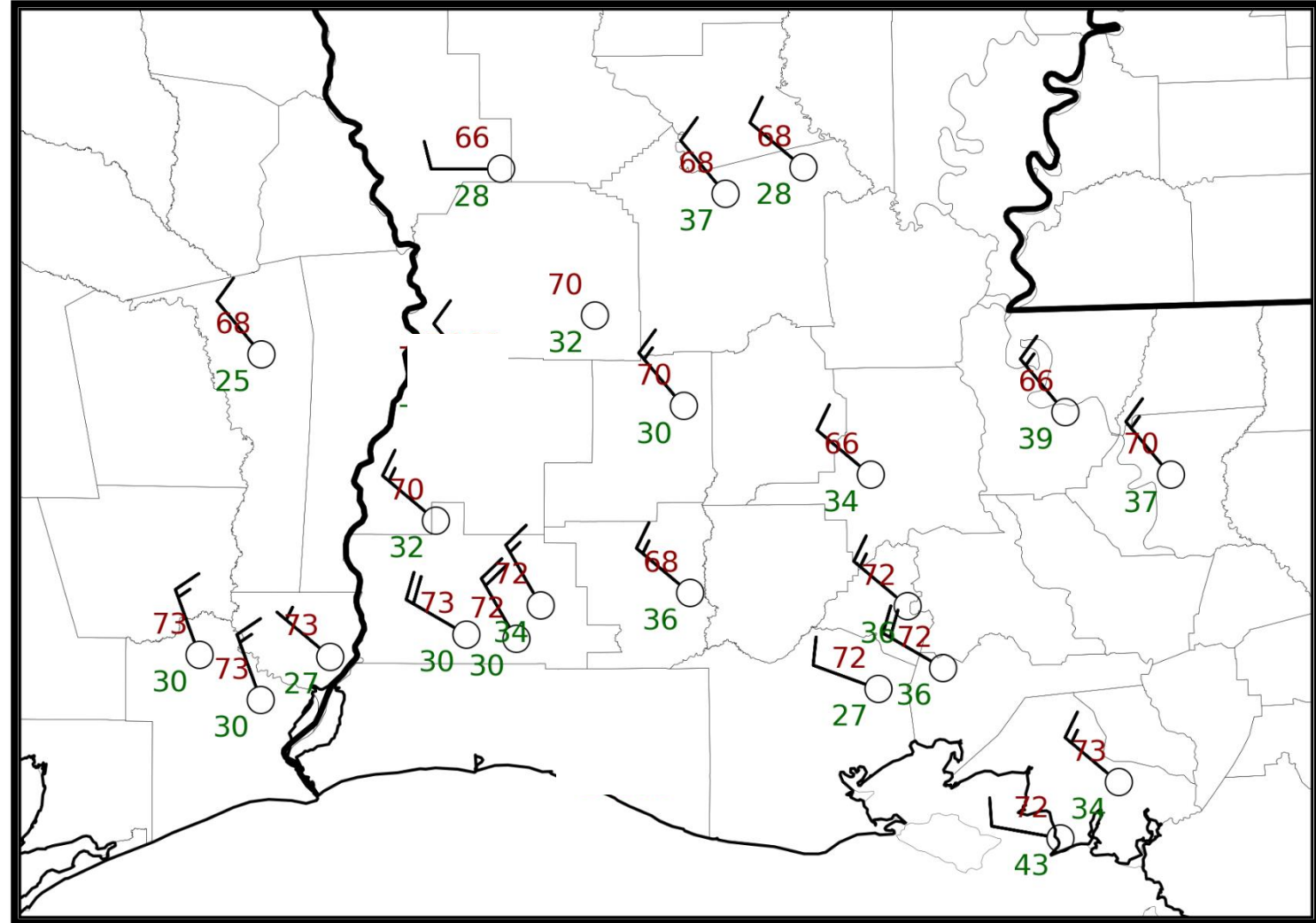


2 pm Weather Observations



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Sunny skies and low humidity continue this afternoon. Temperatures across the region are around 70 with relative humidity values in the 20s and 30s.

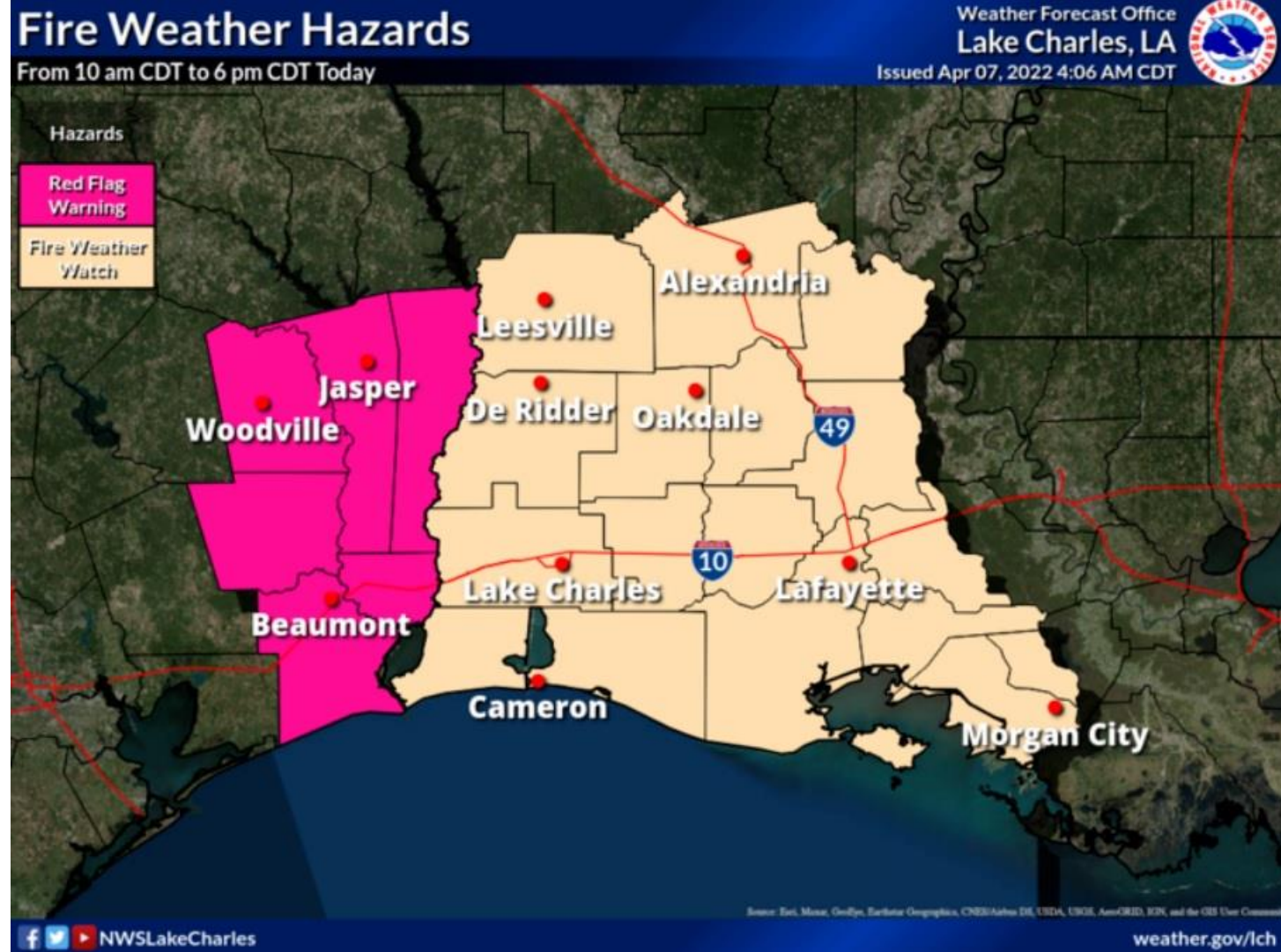


Red Flag Warning



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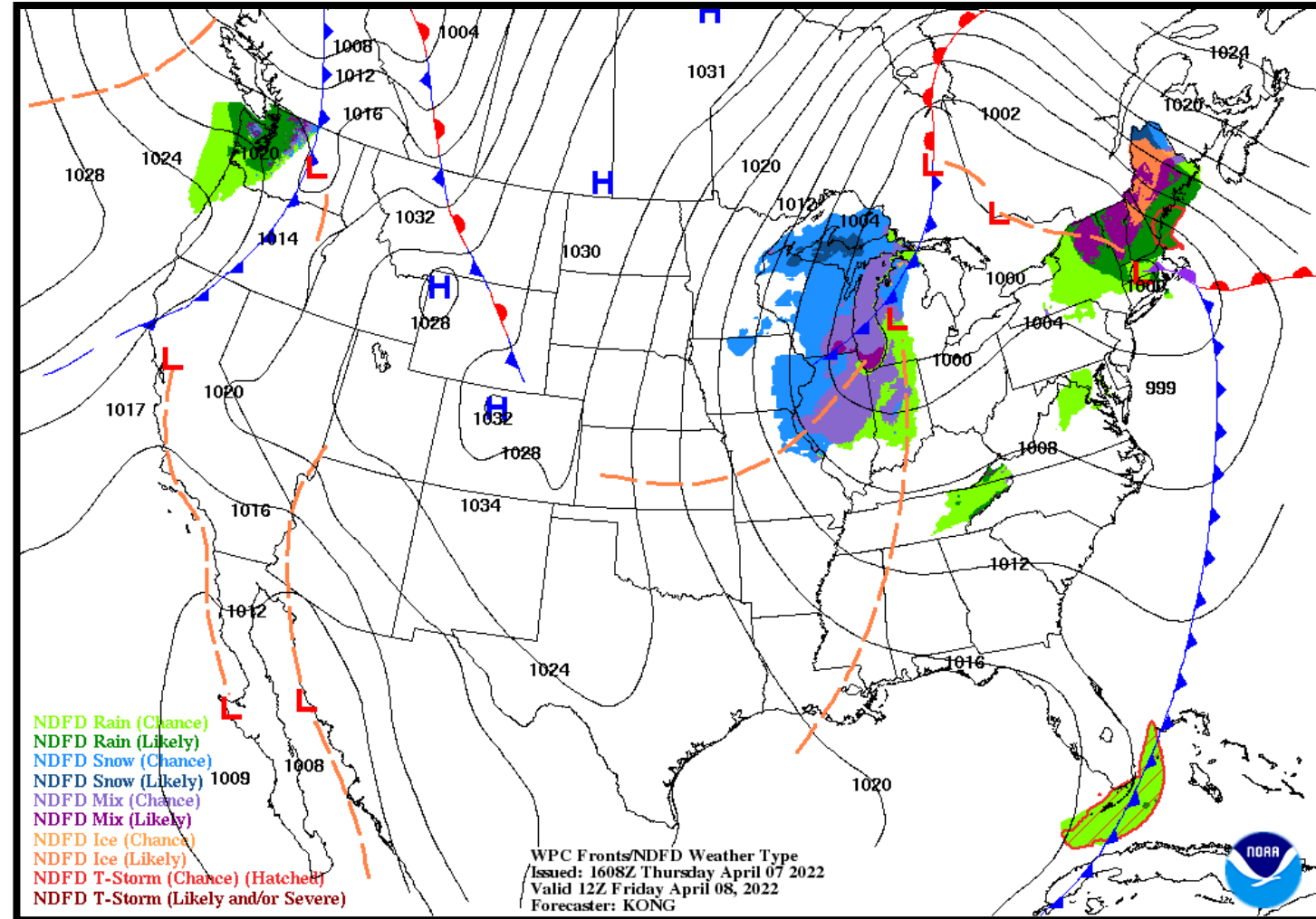
