





Upper Level Steering Patterns




Two upper level low pressure areas are found near Idaho/Nevada and the Great Lakes region.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts






6 am Weather Observations

Winds were from the north at 10 to 15 mph.




2 pm Weather Observations



Rain has moved offshore this afternoon. Skies are cloudy. Temperatures are in the mid 60s to lower 70s.


Winds are out of the northeast at 10 mph.









SPC has most of our region in a marginal 5% risk for severe storms on Friday. WPC has central Louisiana and south central Louisiana in a slight risk for flash flooding.
