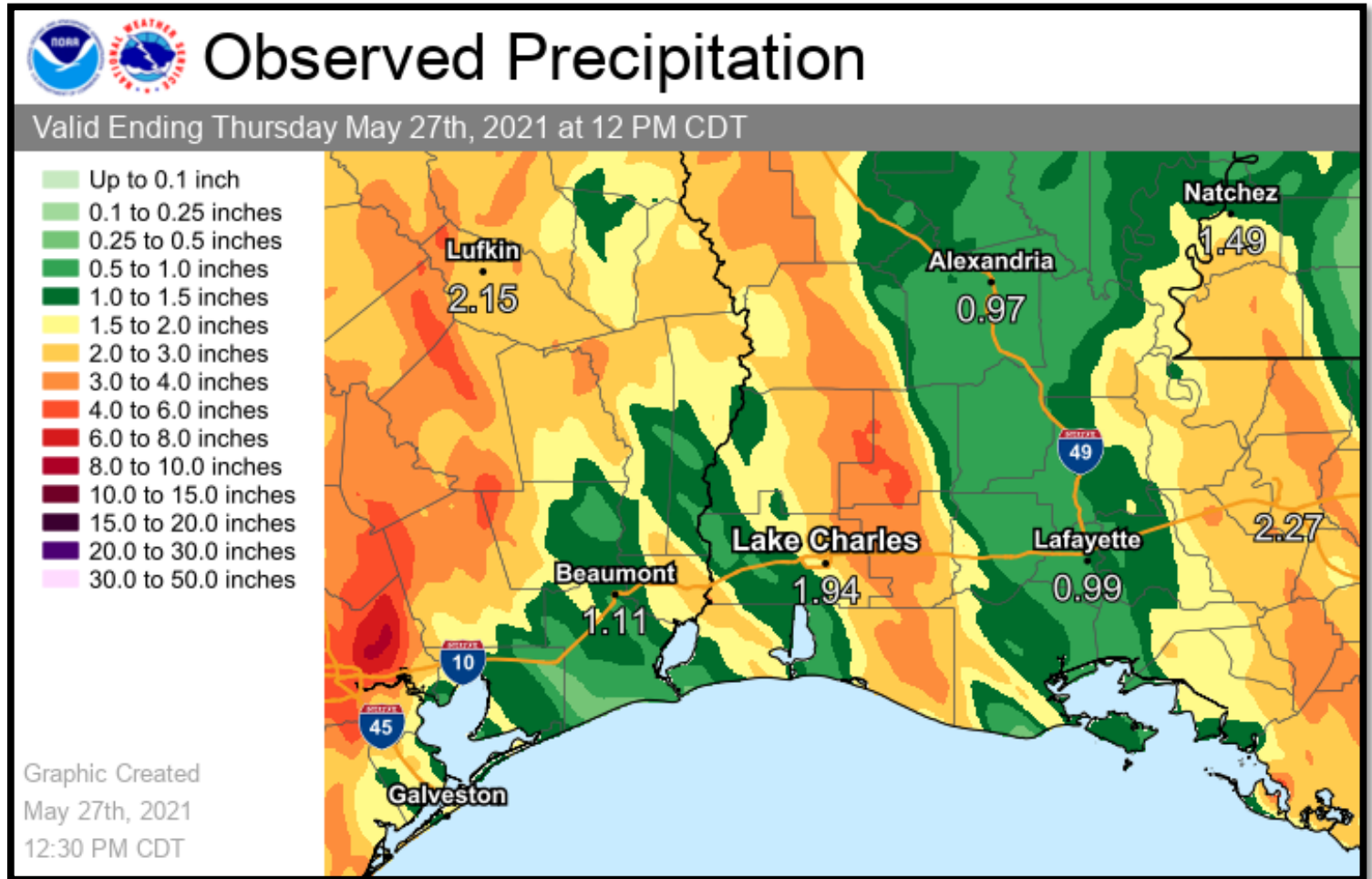

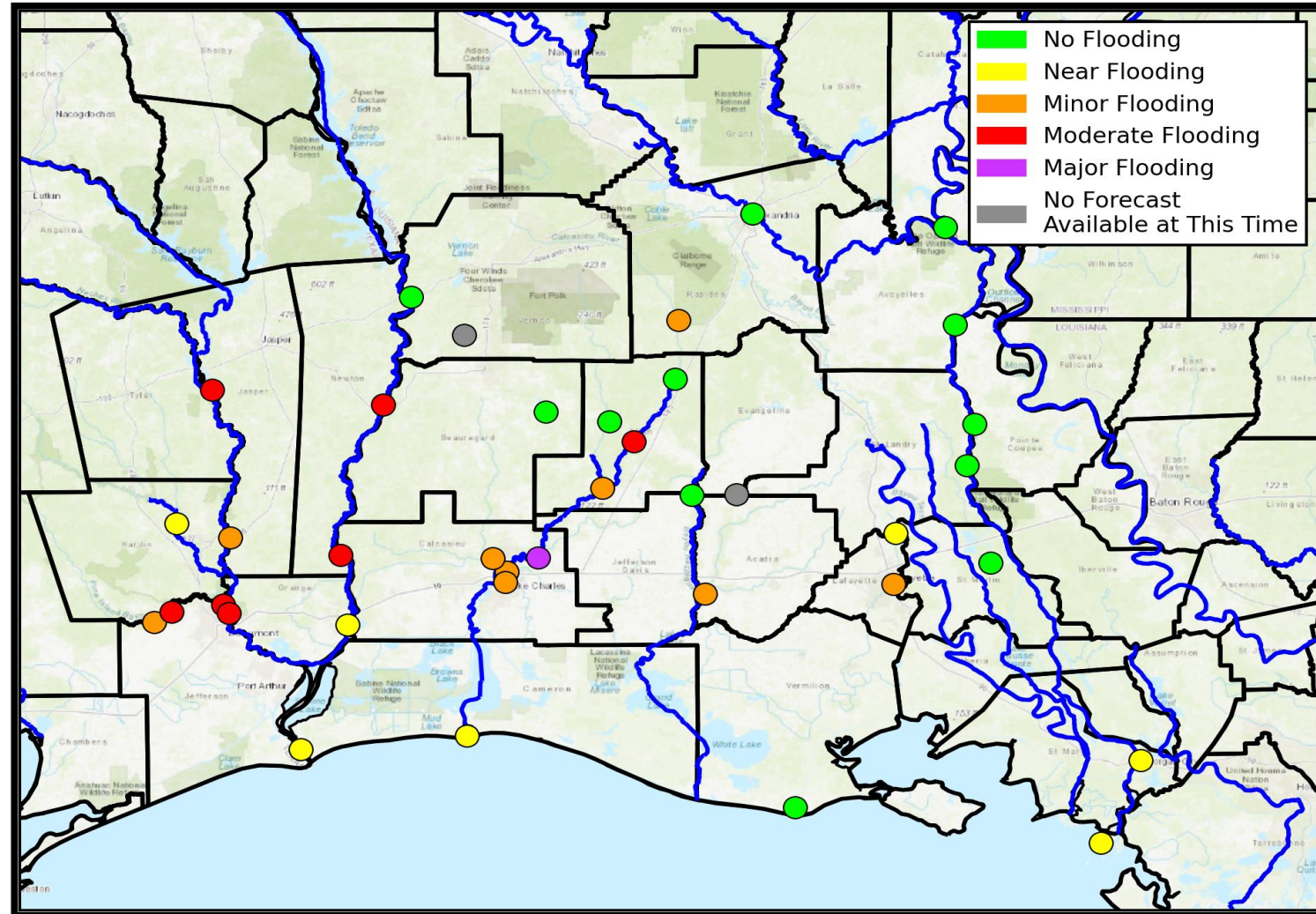
**A “cold” front will push through the area Saturday morning resulting in slightly cooler/drier conditions through Memorial Day.**

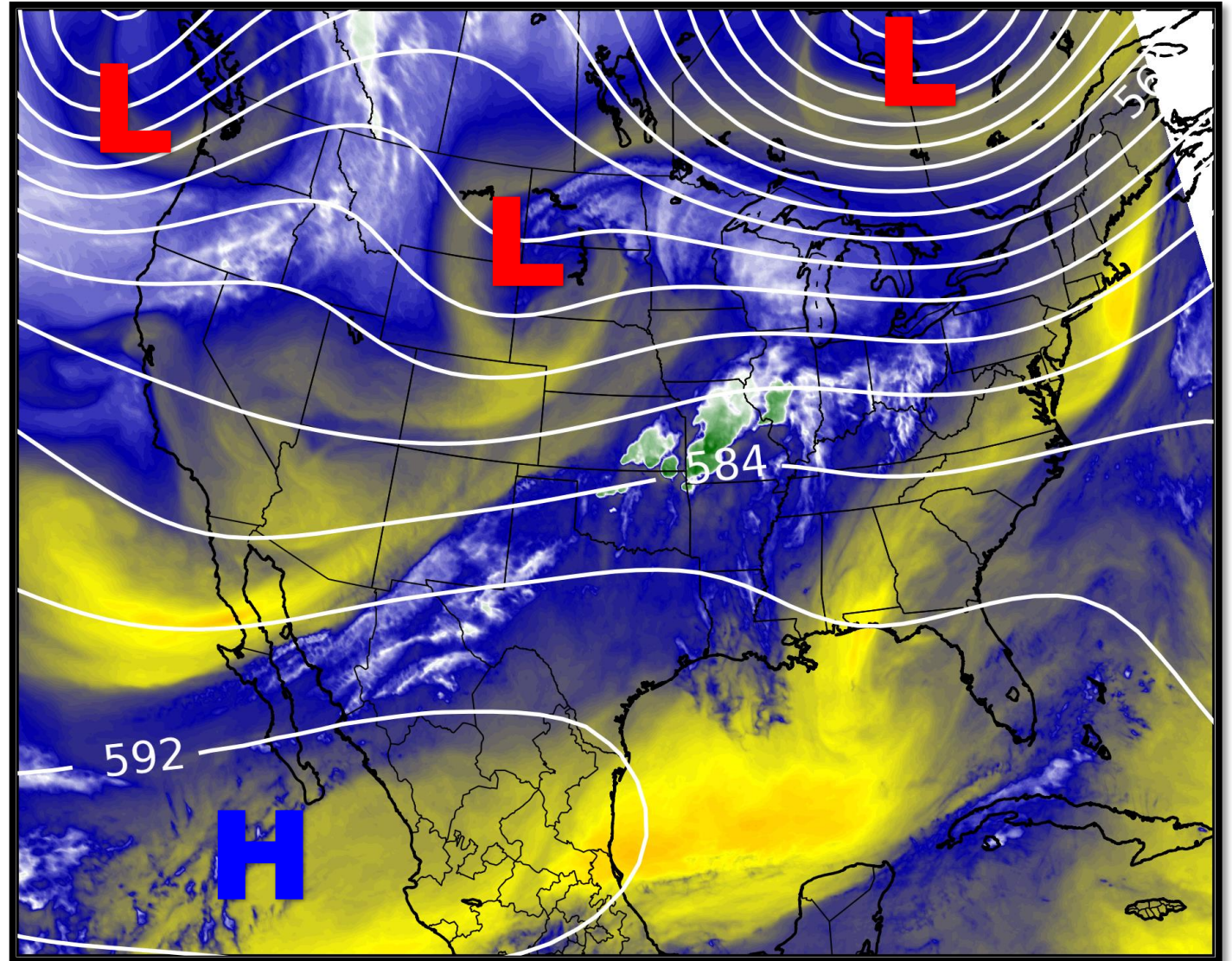


# Upper Level Steering Patterns

A series of upper level lows are moving east across the northern U.S. and Canada.

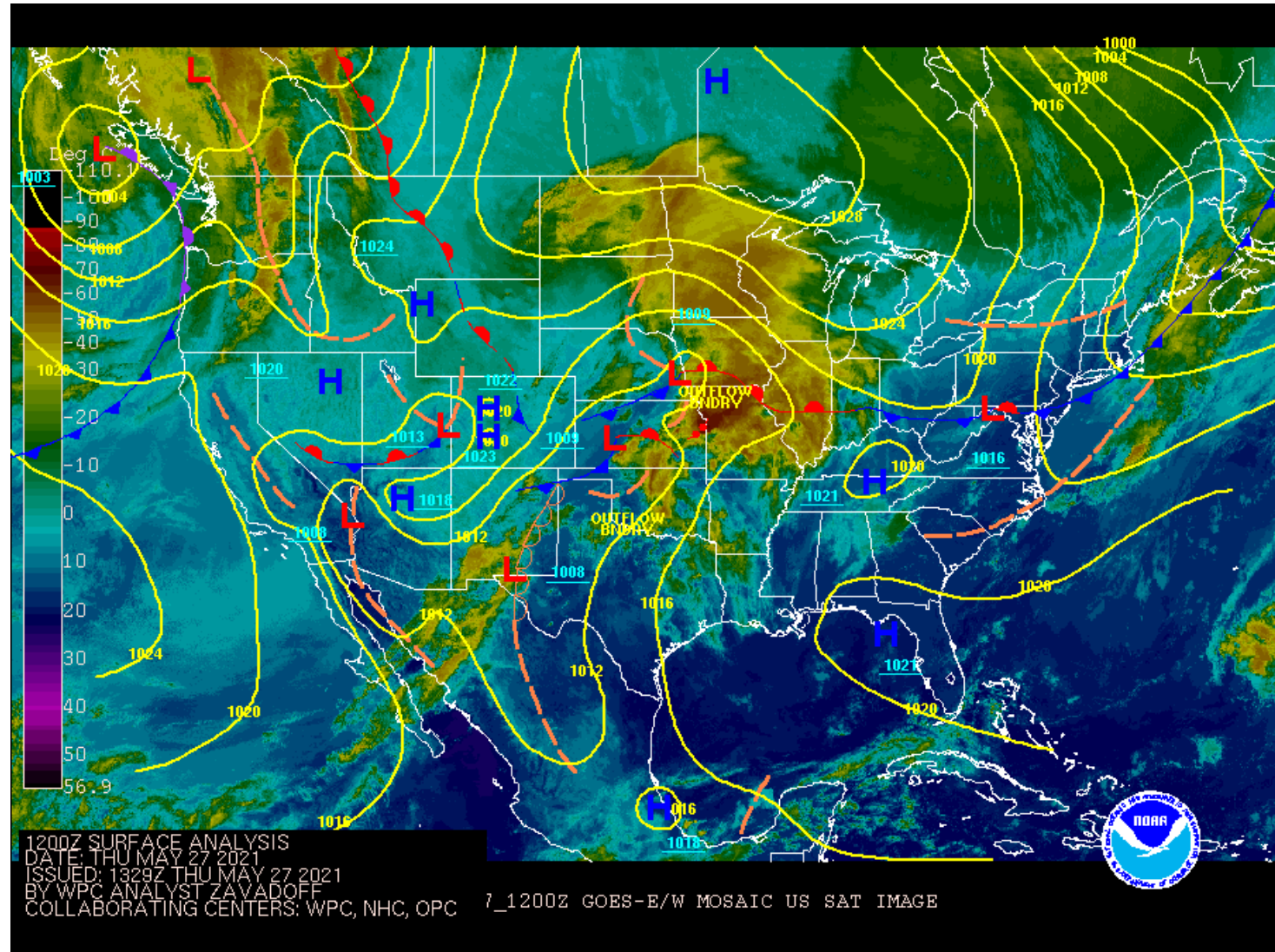


# Surface Weather Map with Fronts

A cold front pushing across Oklahoma today will continue to dig south through the area early Saturday morning.



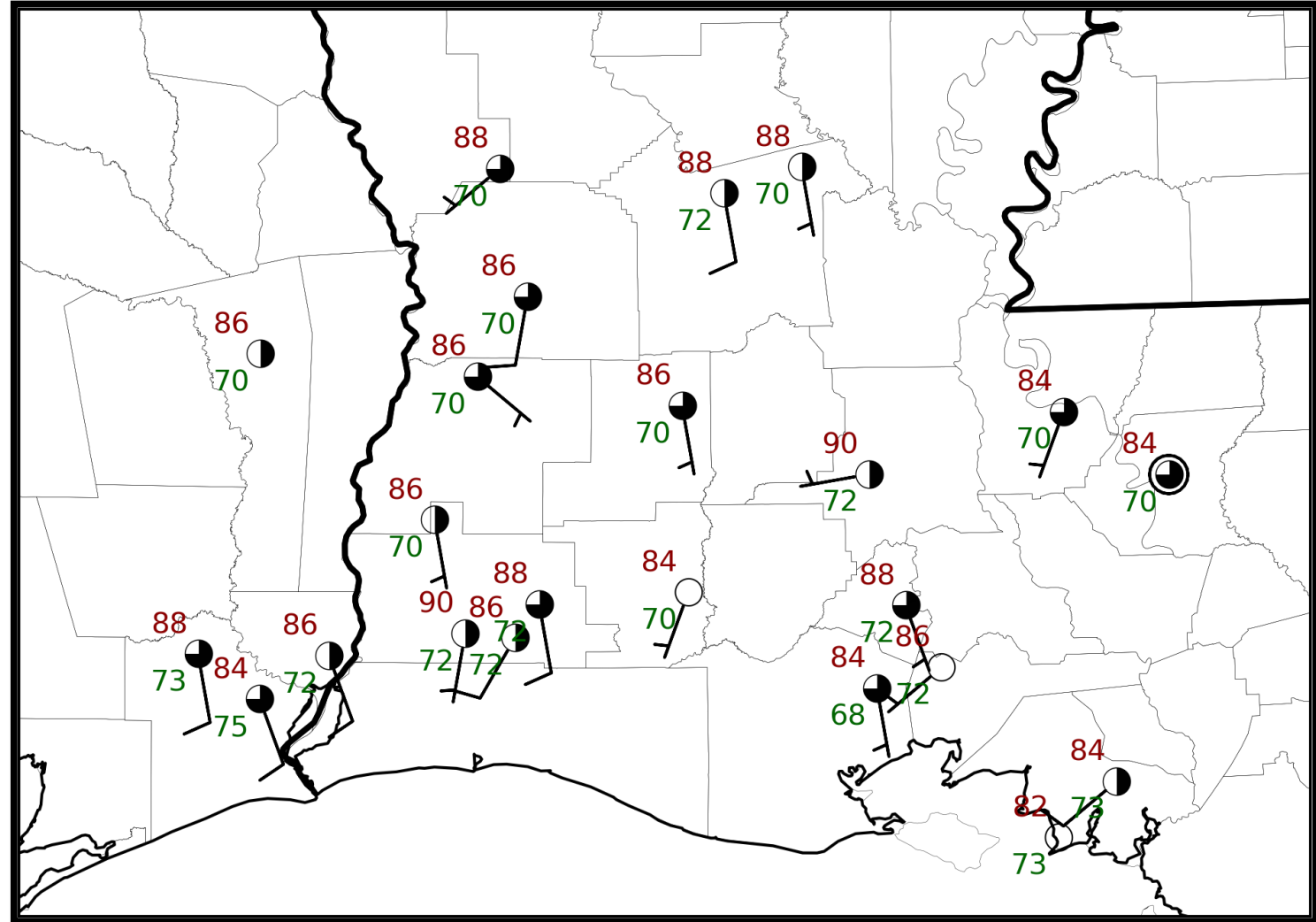


# 2 pm Weather Observations

Afternoon highs will reach the mid to upper 80s with light southerly winds.

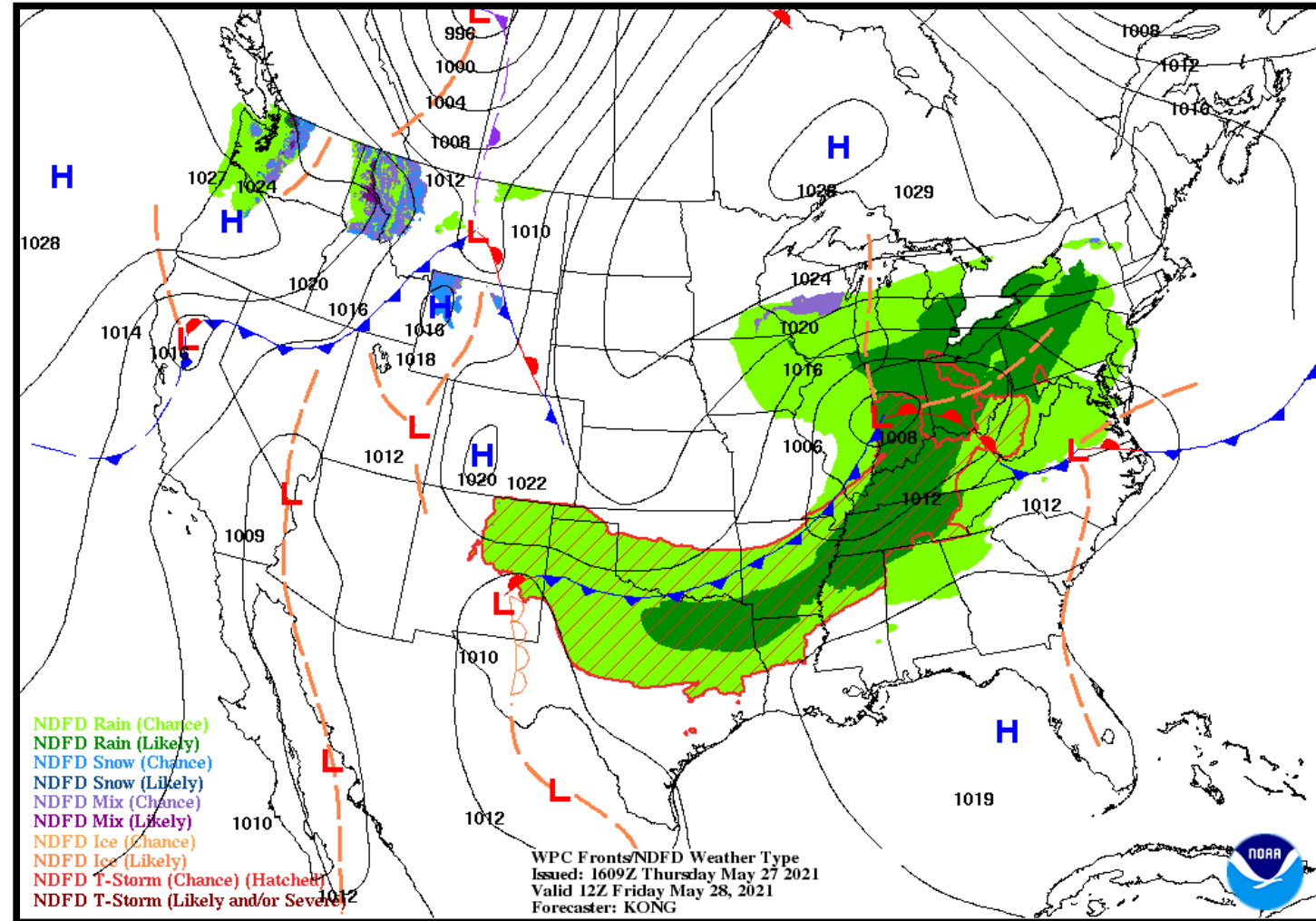
