TOP STORY:

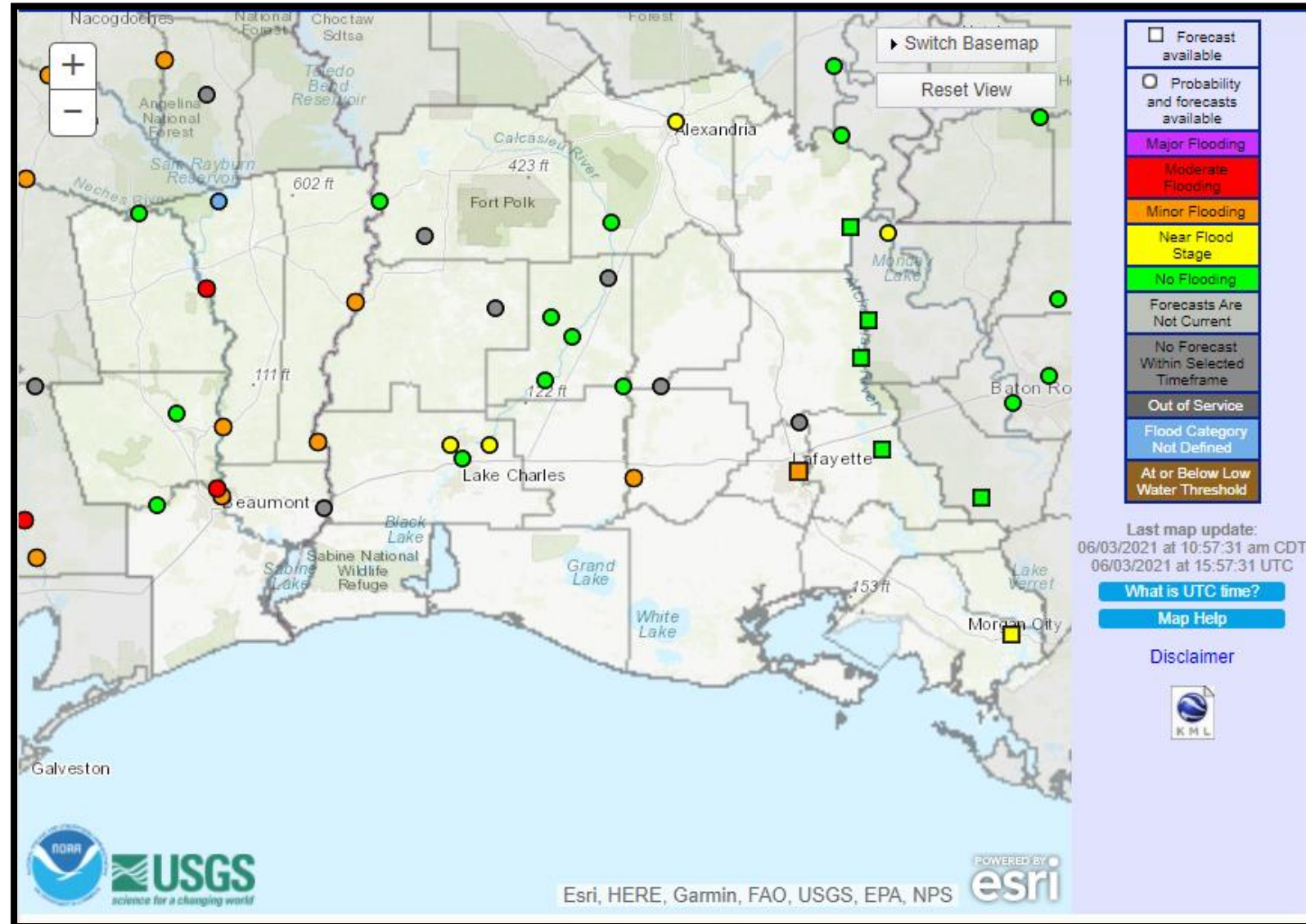
The stormy weather pattern continues through this weekend into next week. 3 to 7 inches of rain is expected. Streets will flood during periods of heavy rain.

Minor to moderate flooding is expected along the Neches River, while minor flooding is expected elsewhere.

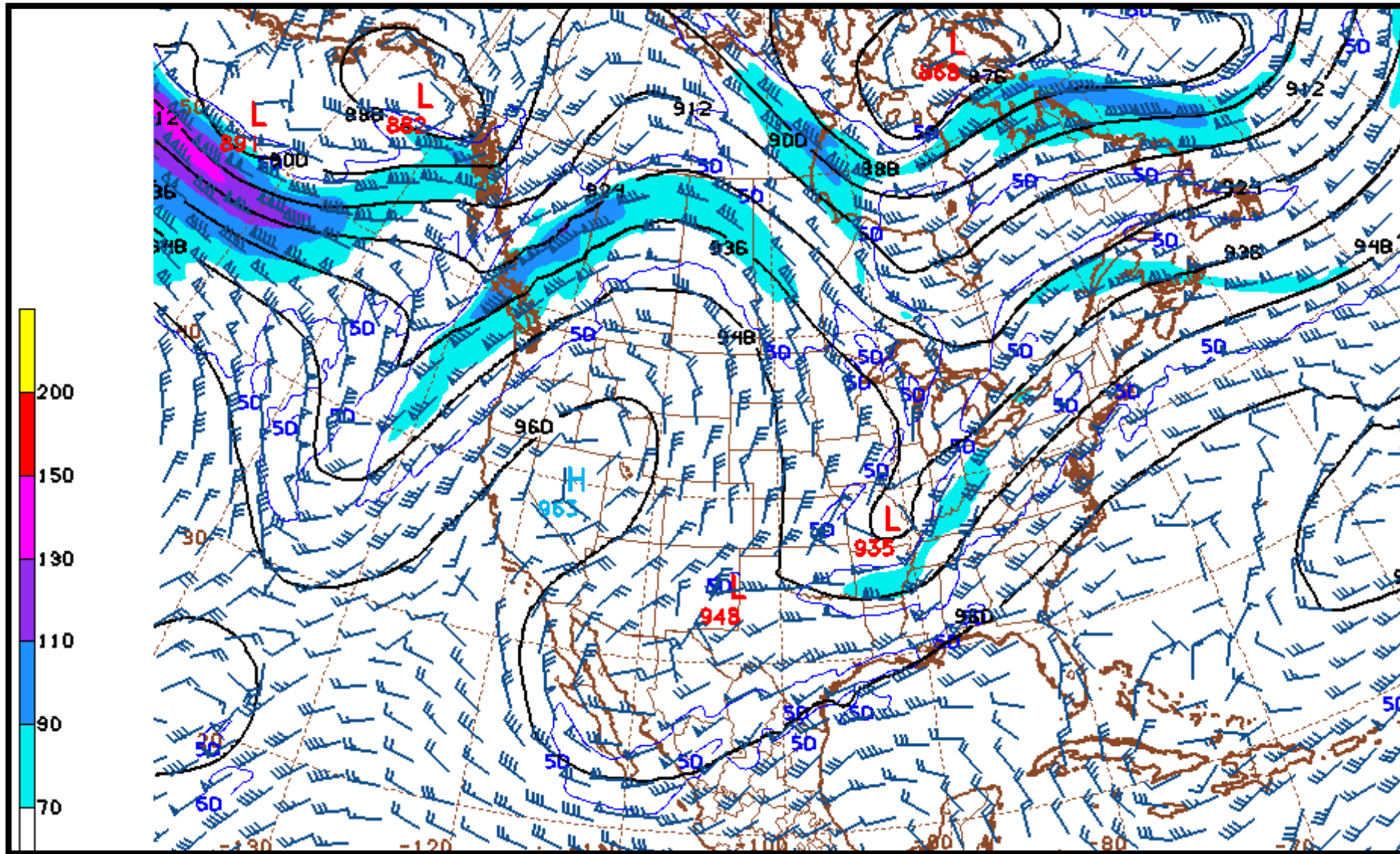
This forecast will likely worsen with the additional rain we get this weekend.



Upper Level Steering Patterns



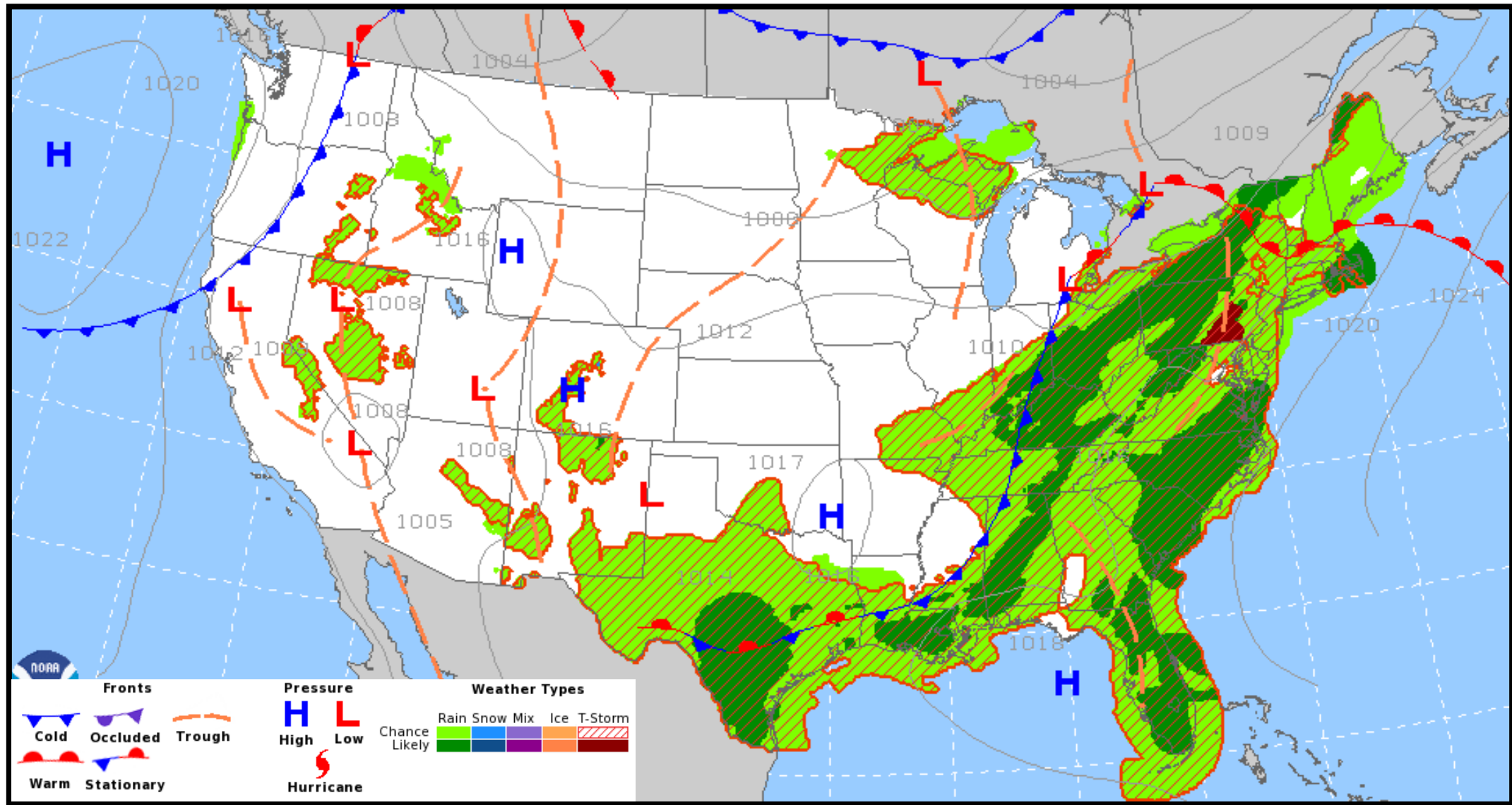

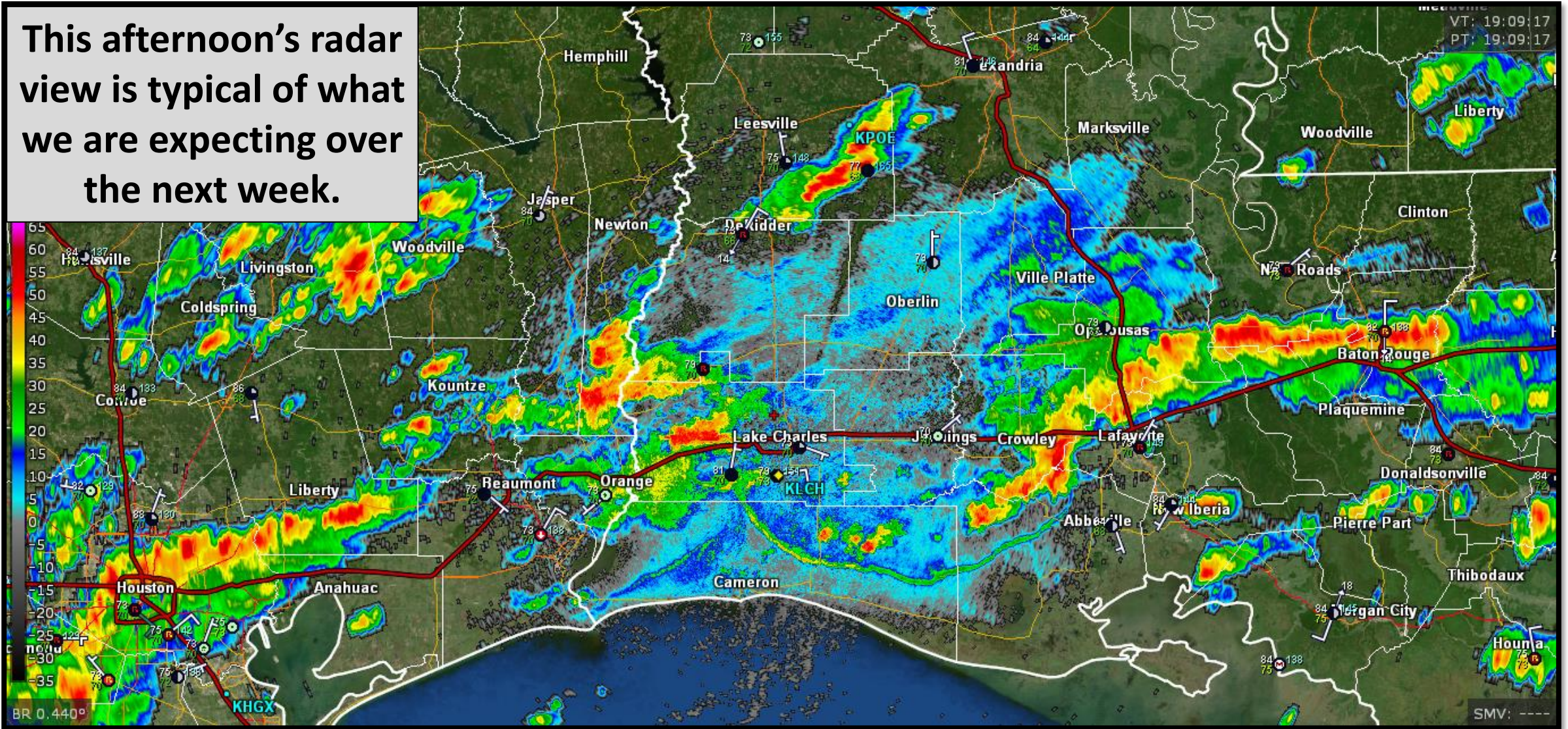

This afternoon's radar view is typical of what we are expecting over the next week.

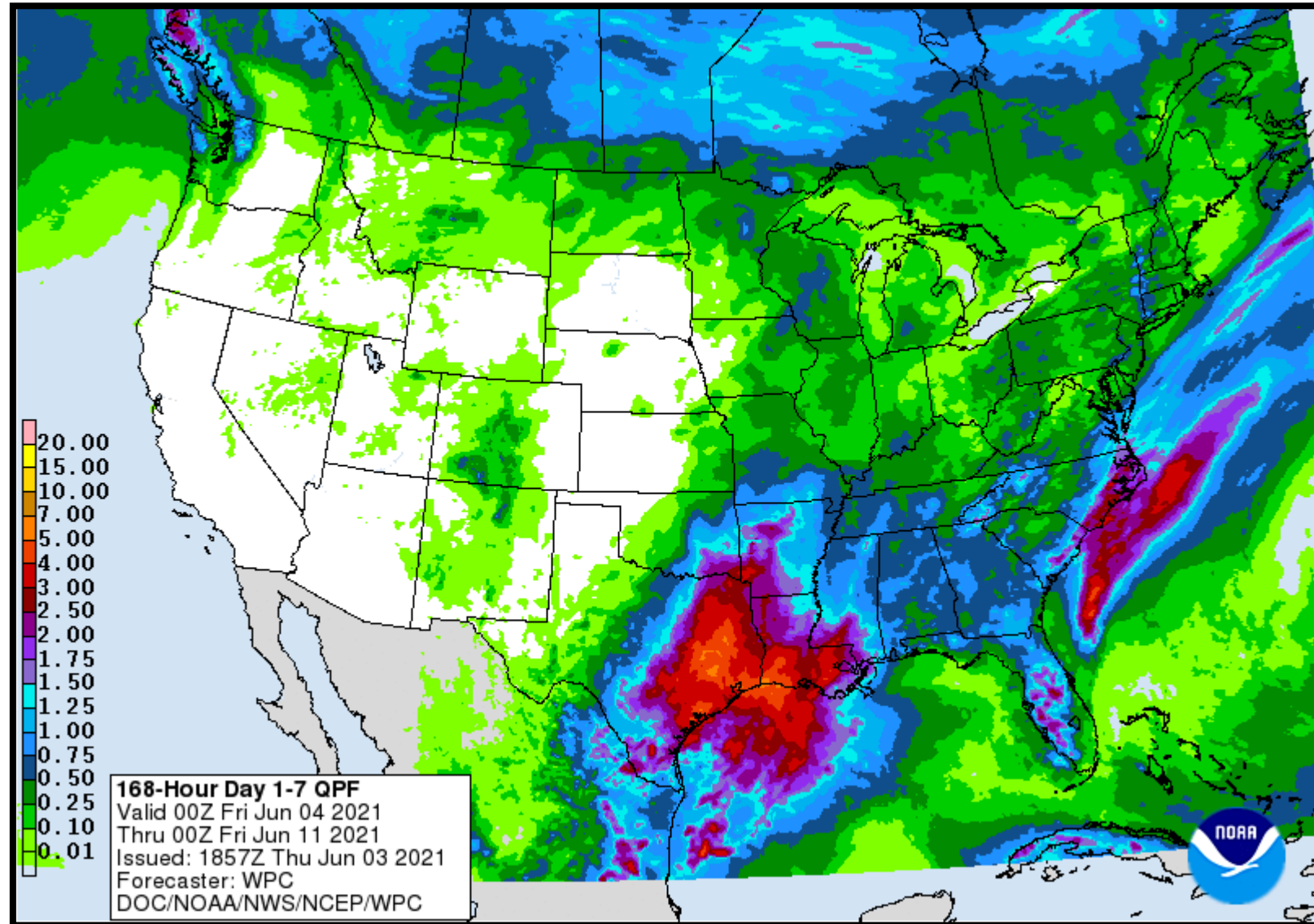


Rainfall Forecast

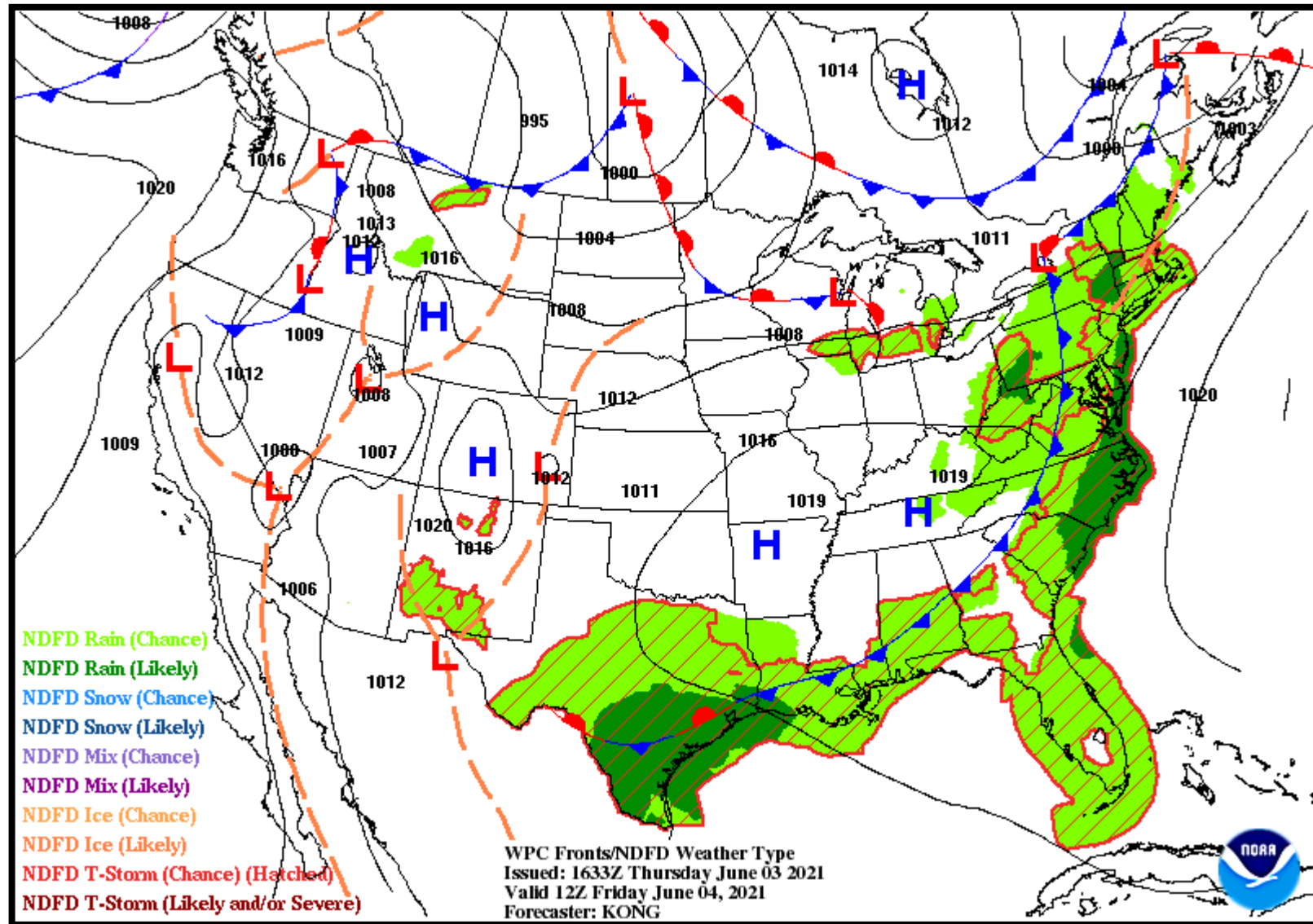
Three to seven inches of rain is expected over the next week, with the majority of it falling Saturday through Tuesday.

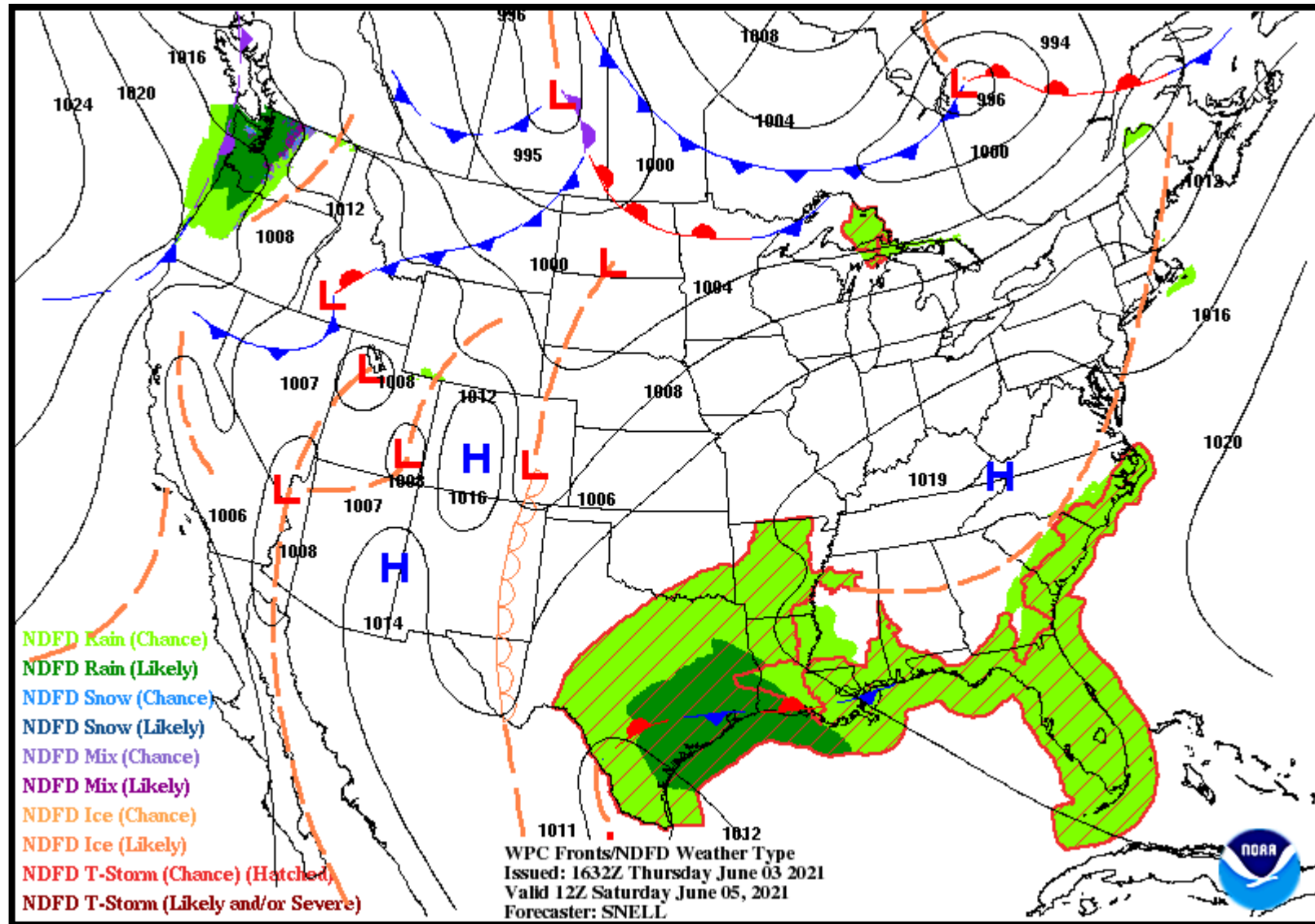
