Near normal temperatures and daily afternoon T-storms through early next week. Higher precipitation chances by mid week in response to a weak disturbance.



Precipitation totals have ranged between zero and three inches over the last week. The region continues to see below normal rainfall totals on both a monthly and annual basis






#### **River Forecasts**



#### There are no ongoing or anticipated river flood concerns.






### **Upper Level Steering Patterns**





A broad upper level ridge remains in place across the western U.S. leading to record breaking temperatures. An upper level trof axis extends from the great lakes into the Florida peninsula this afternoon.






## Surface Weather Map with Fronts



Weak high pressure remains in place across the southeastern U.S. resulting in steady light to moderate southerly winds across our region. A nearly stationary frontal boundary across Arkansas is providing some support for thunderstorms this afternoon.






#### 6 am Weather Observations



Isolated showers and thunderstorms associated with a stationary frontal boundary was observed aross parts of central Louisiana this morning.






### 2 pm Weather Observations

- Precipitation chances will increase Tuesday and Wednesday as a weak disturbance moves from east to west across the region.
- Tropics remain quiet with no development expected over the next five days
