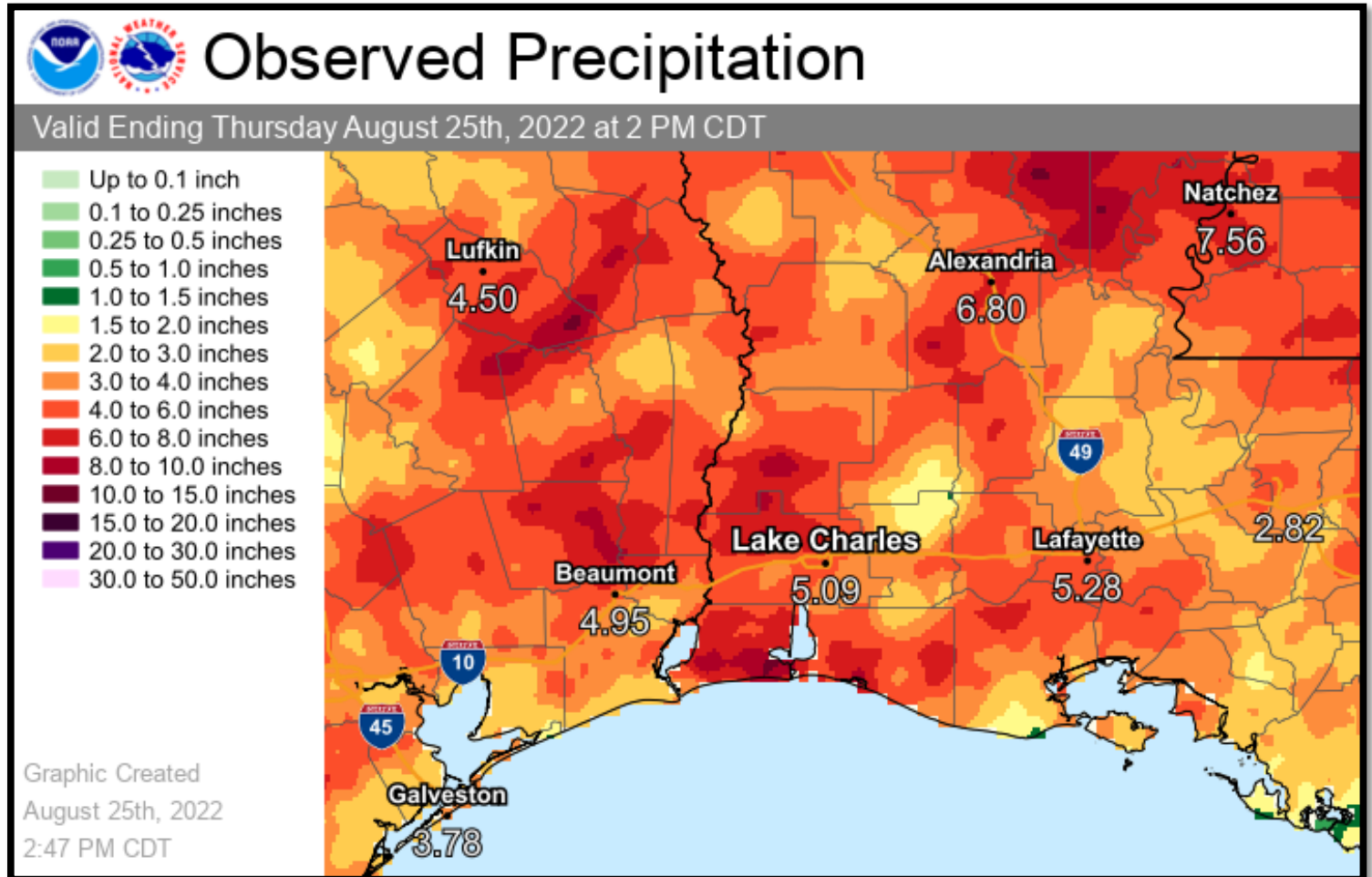


## TOP STORY:

**Overall wetter than normal pattern will continue for another week. Tropics remain quiet for now.**

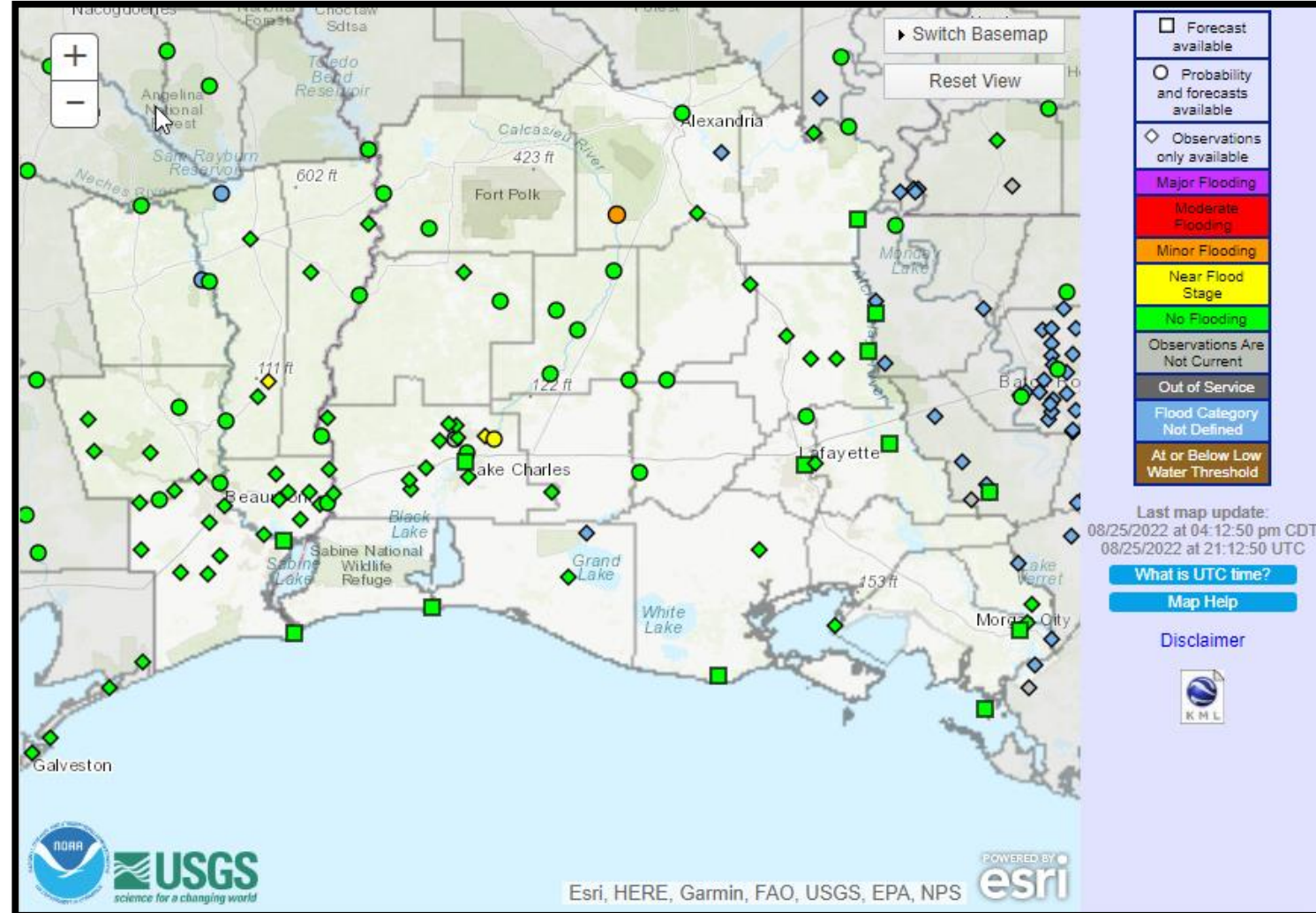
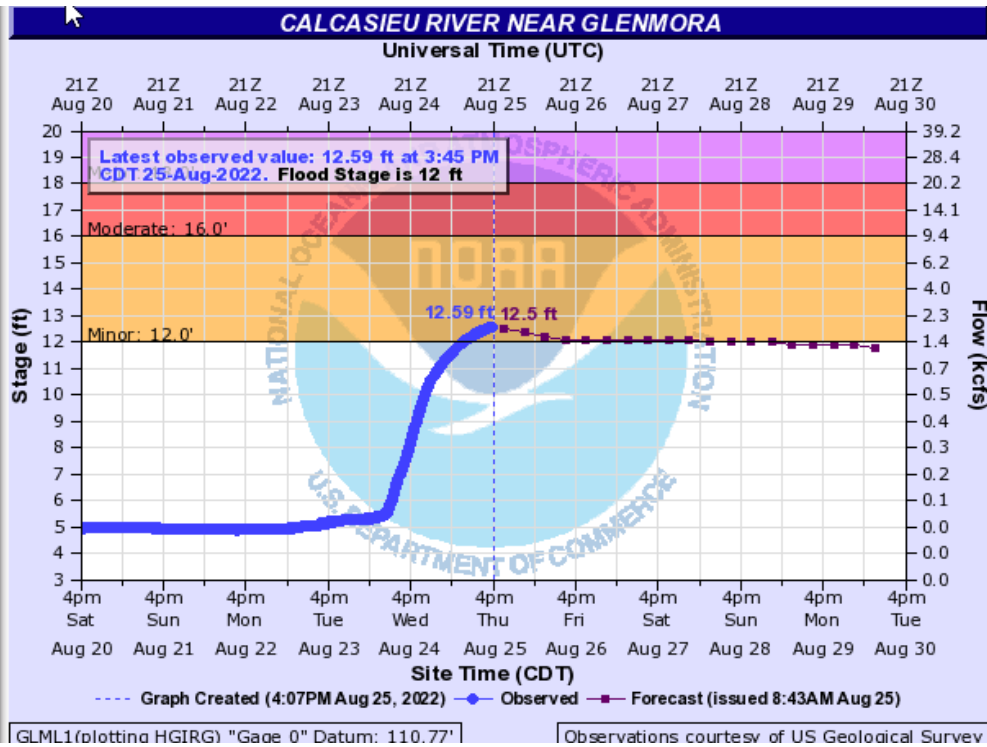


# River Forecasts



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Rises on most area rivers due to recent rainfall, but only forecast point in flood (minor) is Glenmora along the Calcasieu River.

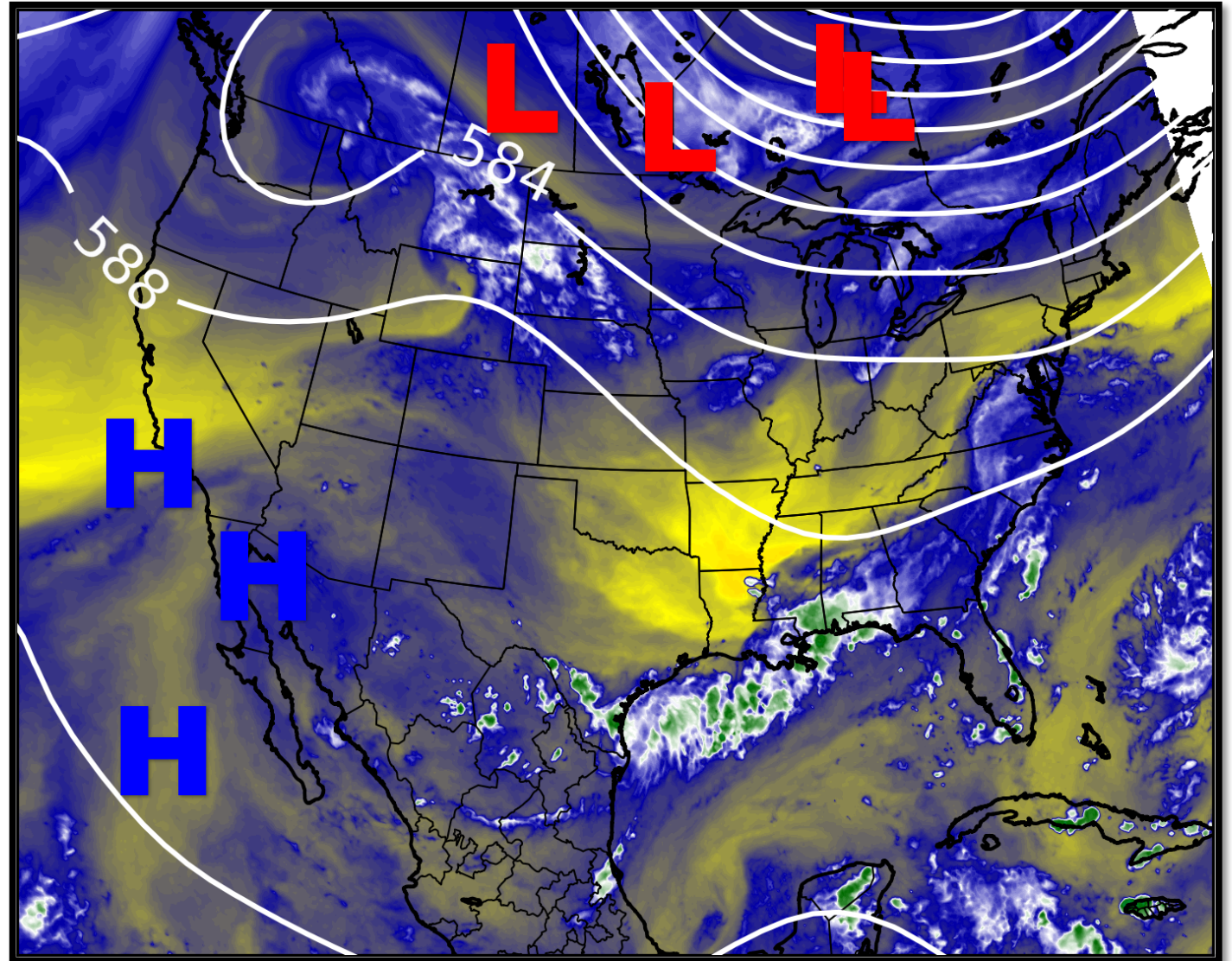


# Upper Level Steering Patterns



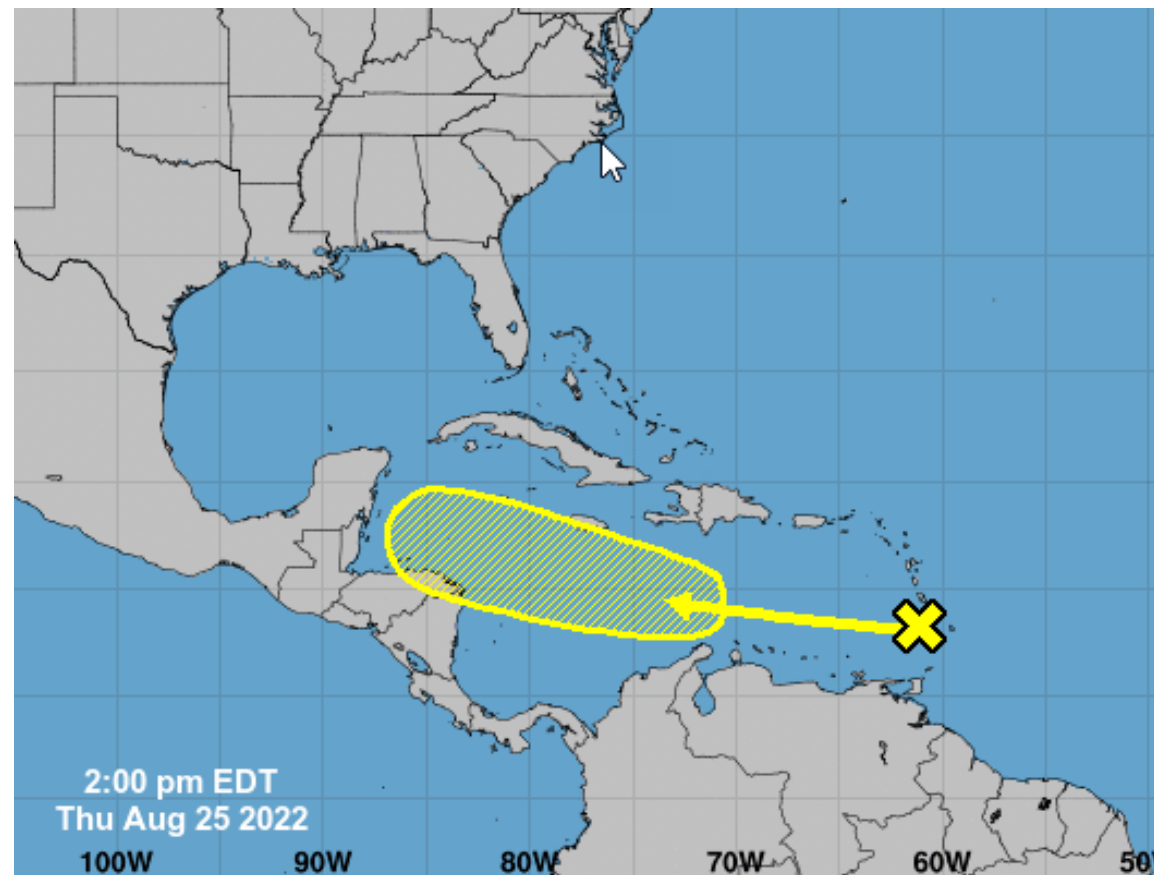
Lake Charles  
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Ridge of high pressure centered near the Four Corners. Mean upper trough of low pressure over the Great Lakes to the Central Gulf Coast.



Near the Windward Islands: A trough of low pressure located near the Windward Islands is producing disorganized shower and thunderstorm activity. This system is expected to move westward at about 15 mph during the next several days, and environmental conditions could become more conducive for slow development when it moves across the central and western Caribbean Sea early next week.

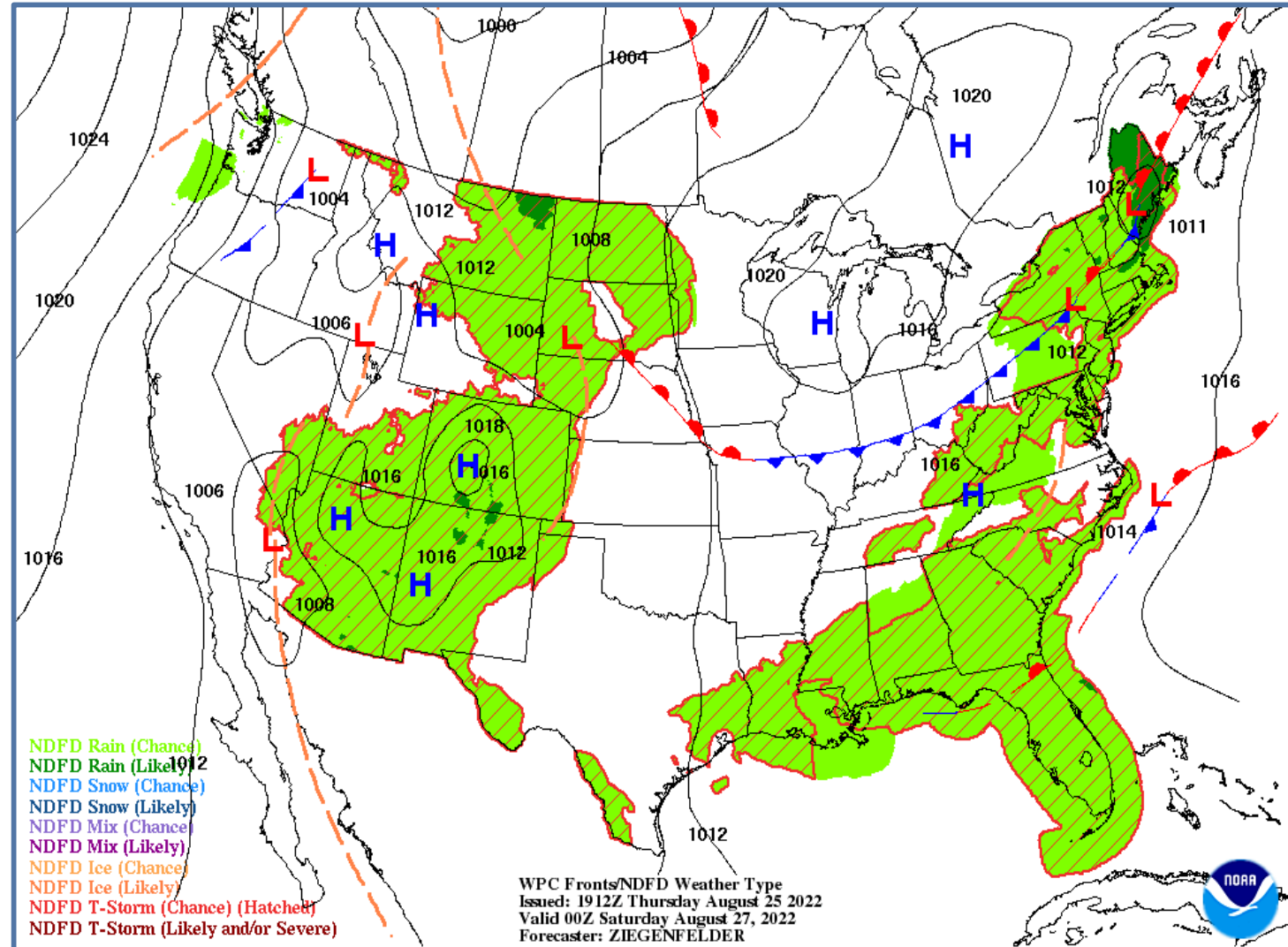
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...near 0 percent.
