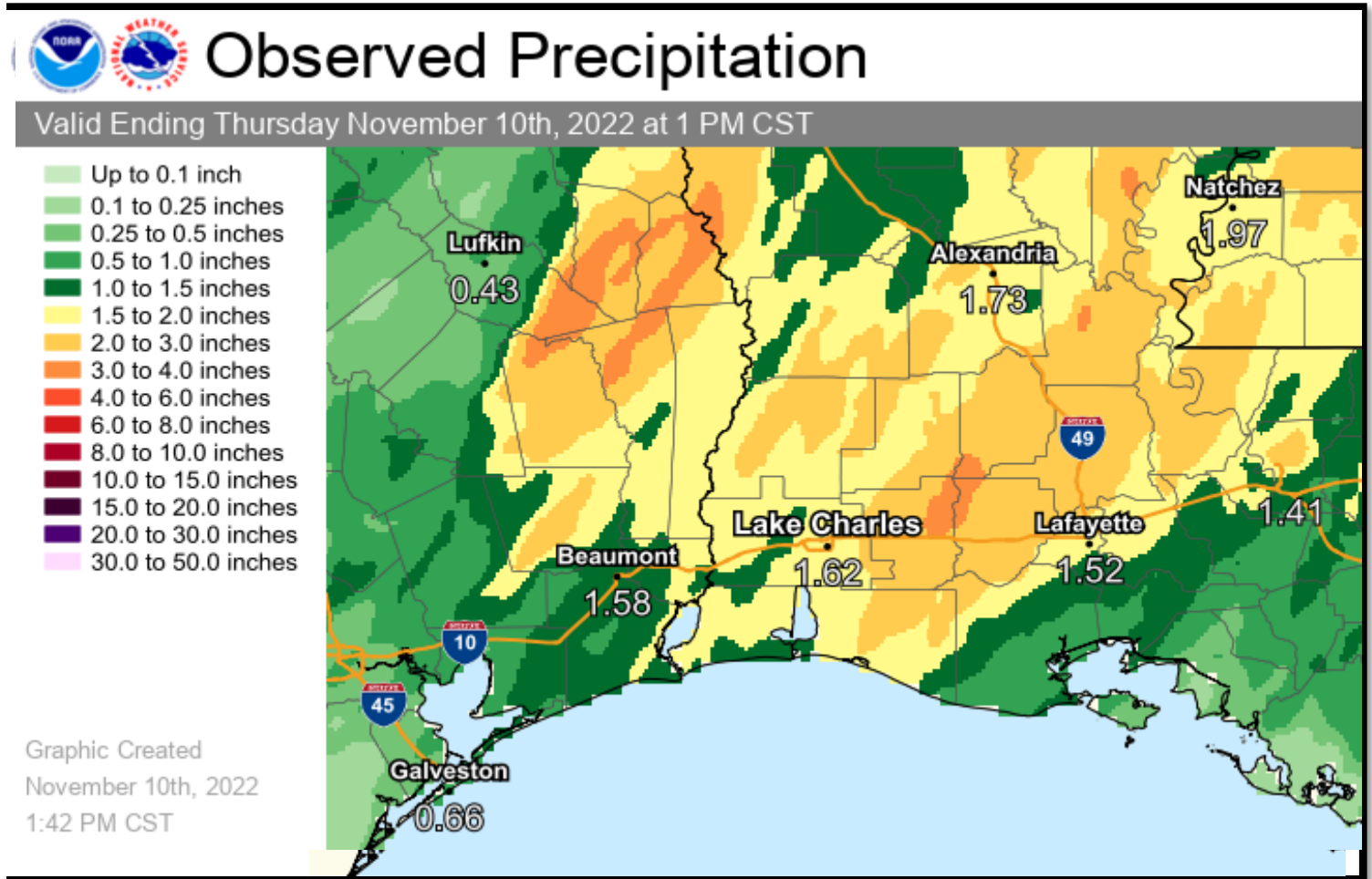

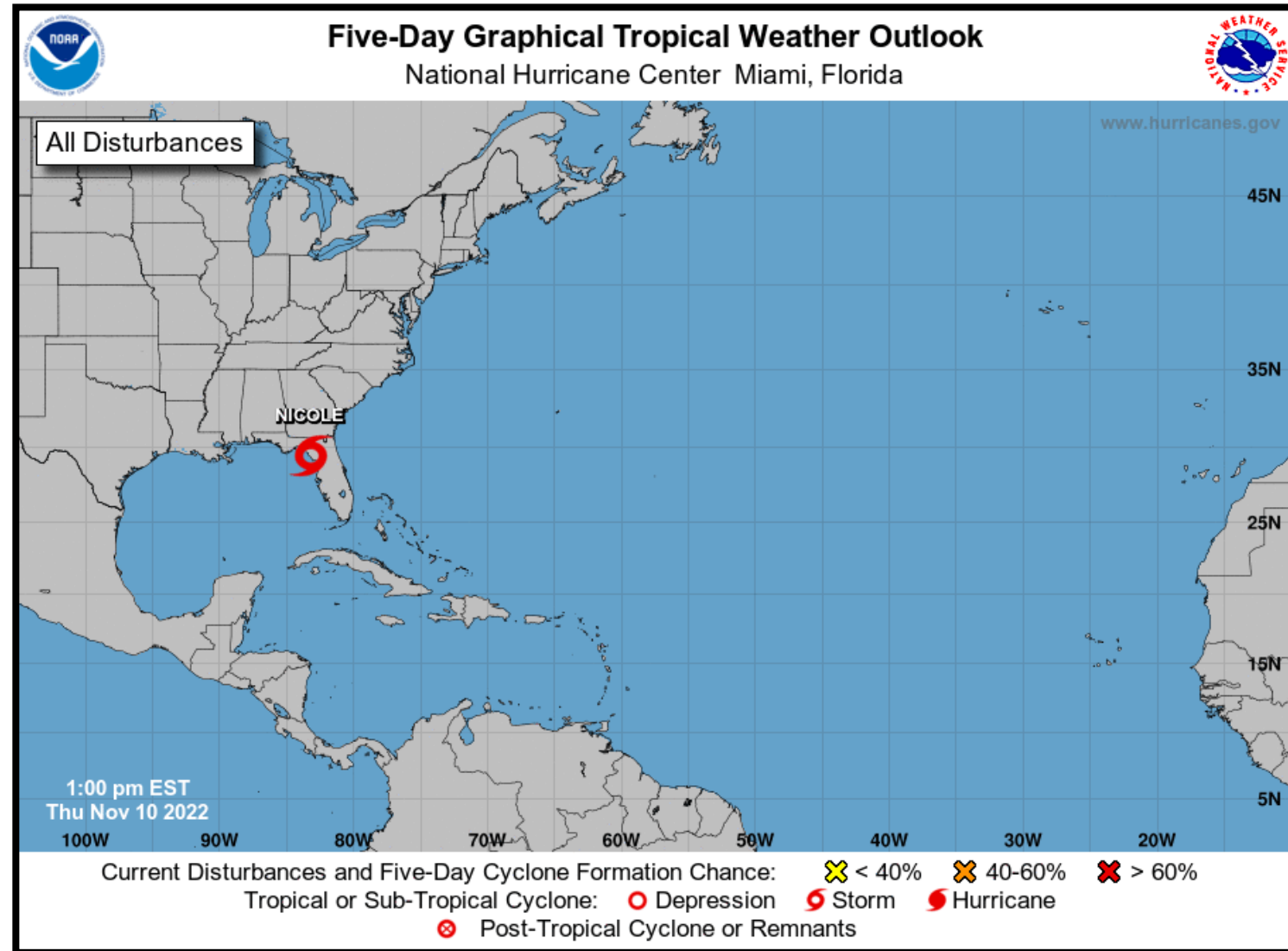
A strong cold front will move through the area Friday night into Saturday morning ushering in much cooler weather through next week.

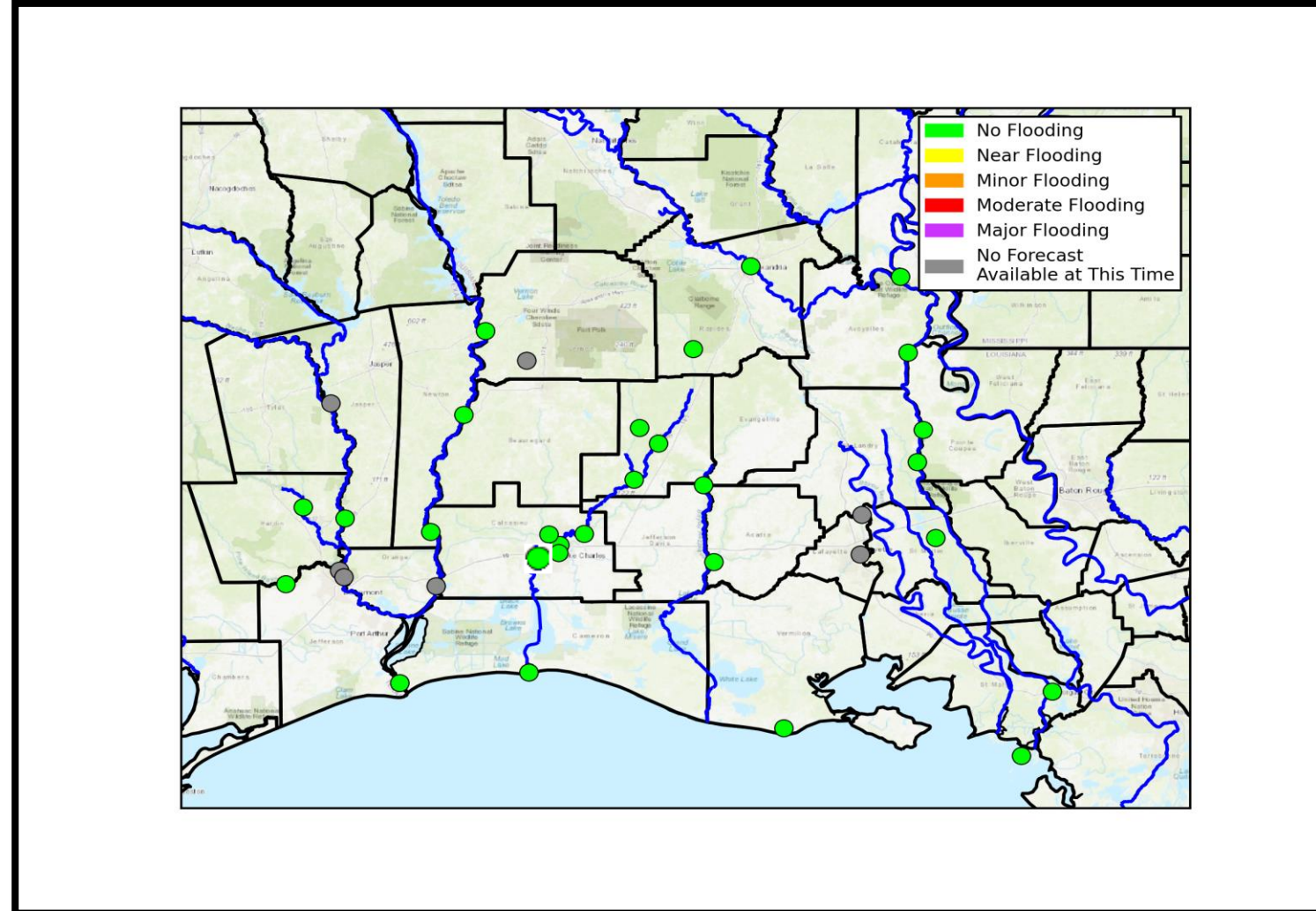
Most of the region saw between 1.5 to 2 inches of rainfall over the last week. Much of the area remains abnormally dry or in moderate drought.

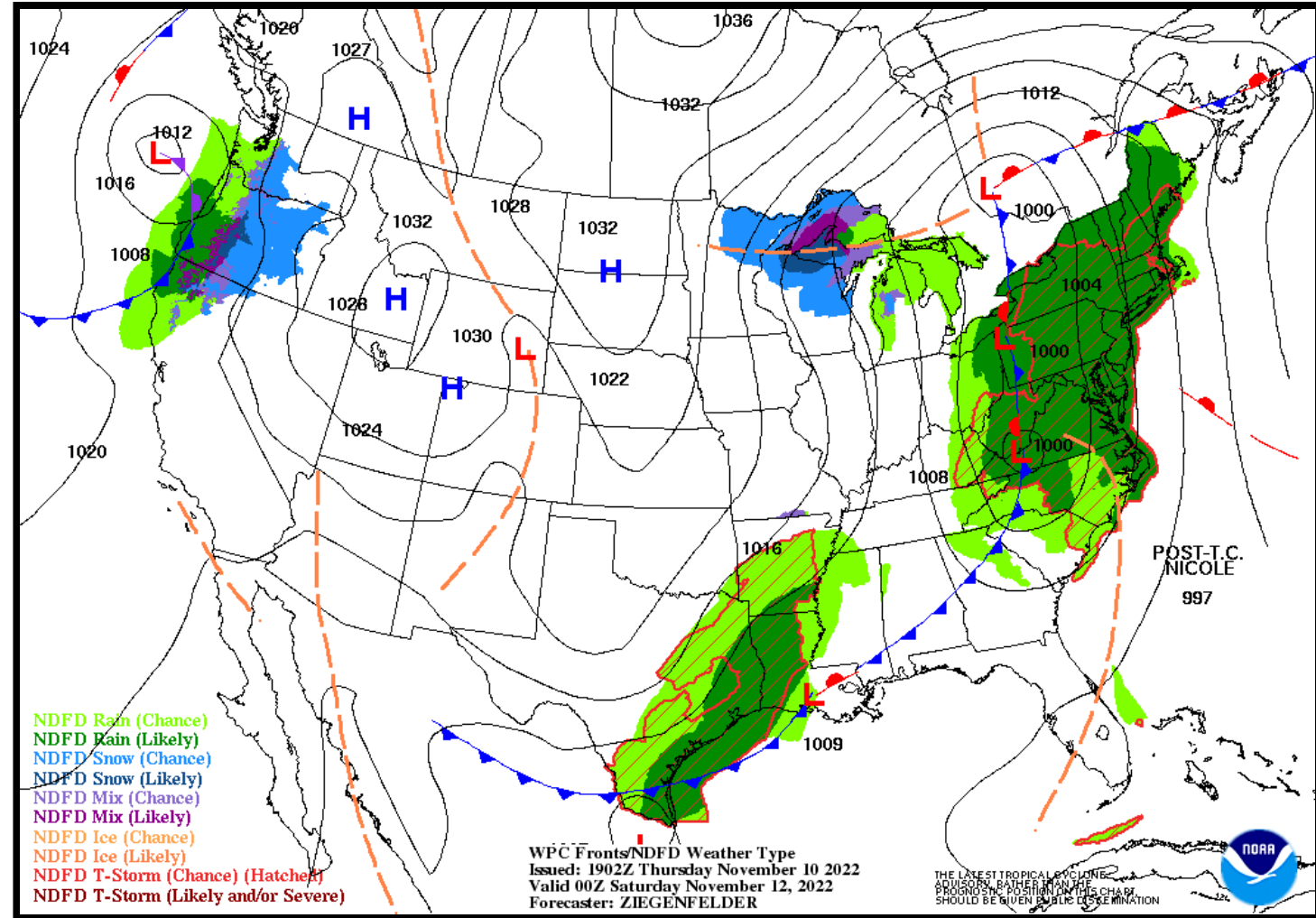


Pleasant and sunny conditions to persist for the rest of the day with cool temperatures expected tonight. Patchy fog will be possible overnight.
