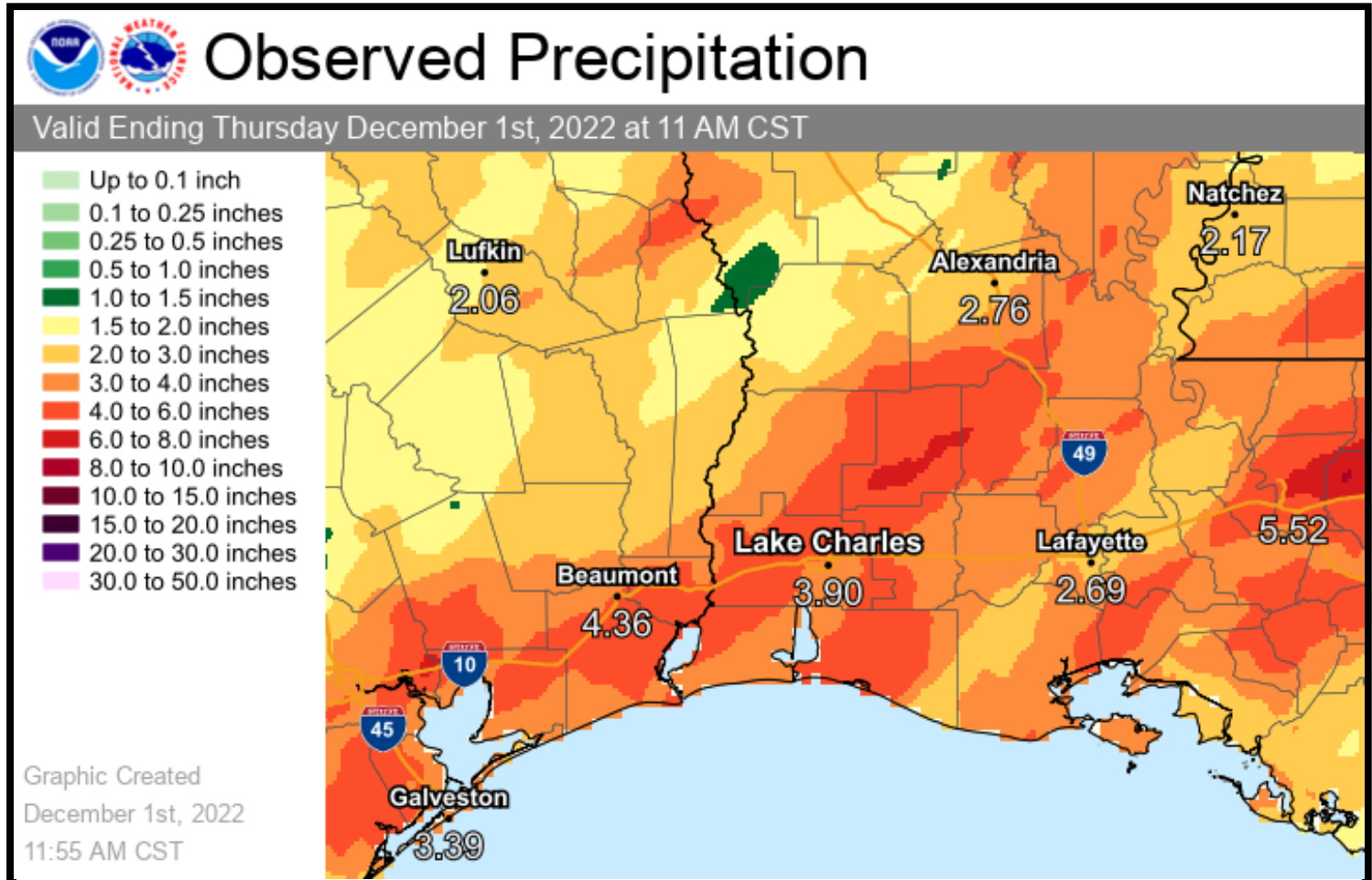


# TOP STORY:

**Above normal temperatures expected for the week. Weak cold fronts will stall in the region Saturday and again Thursday. Fog may be an issue Saturday morning and early next week, especially near the coast.**

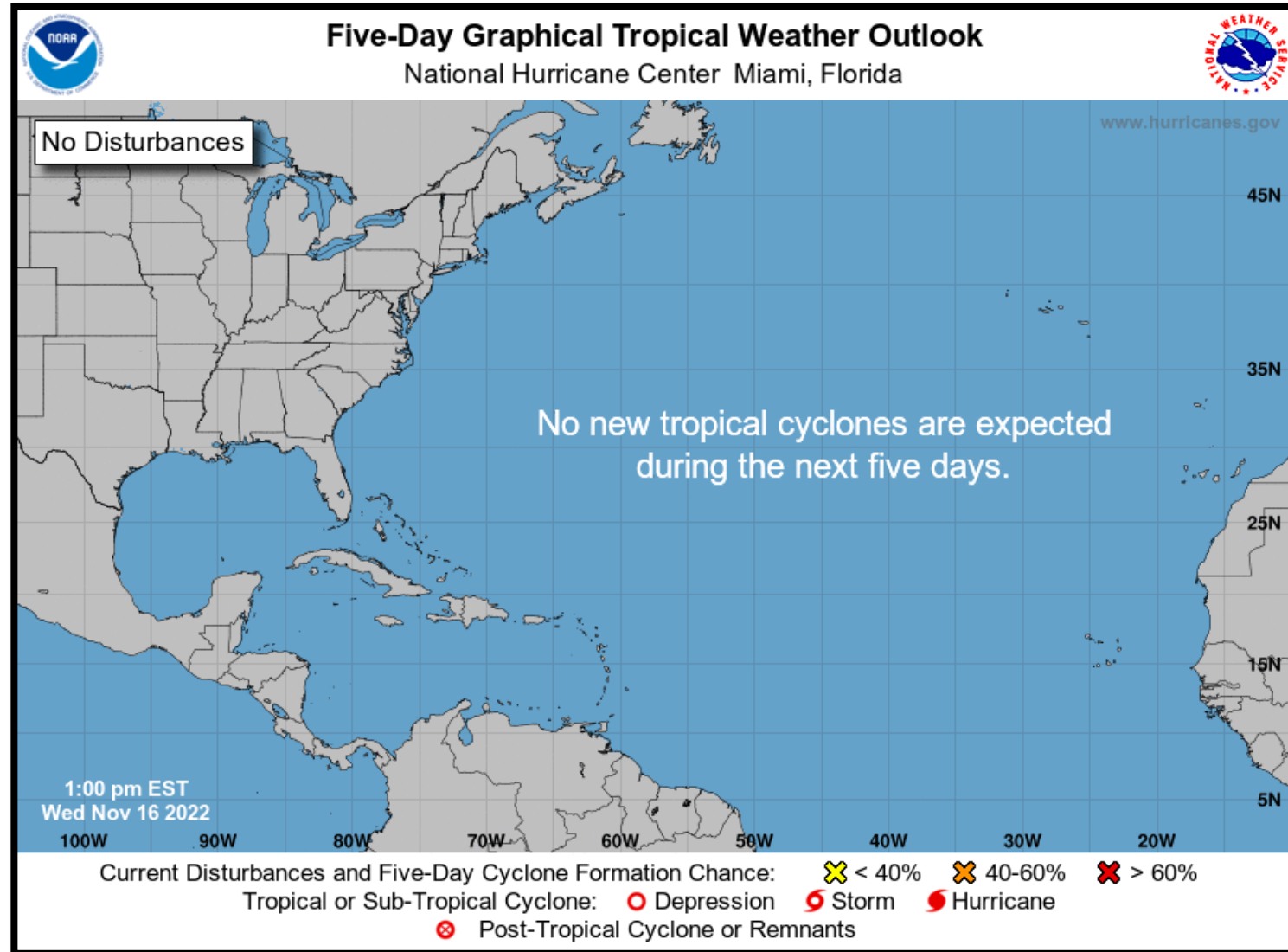

Multiple days of rainfall affected the area late last week into the weekend with 1 to 5 inches of accumulation.

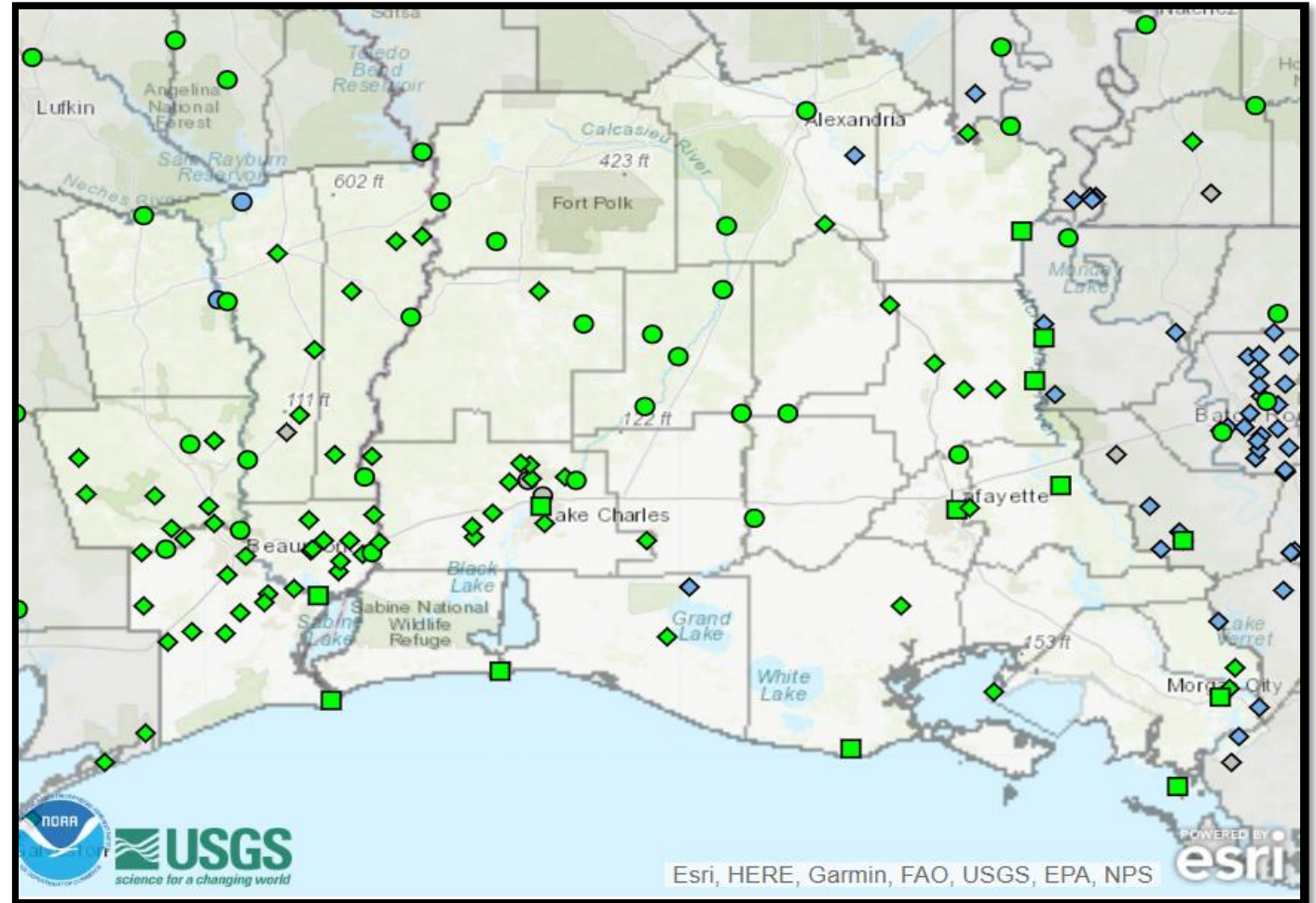




**Hurricane Season is over!**



No rivers are currently in flood event with widespread rain over the past week.



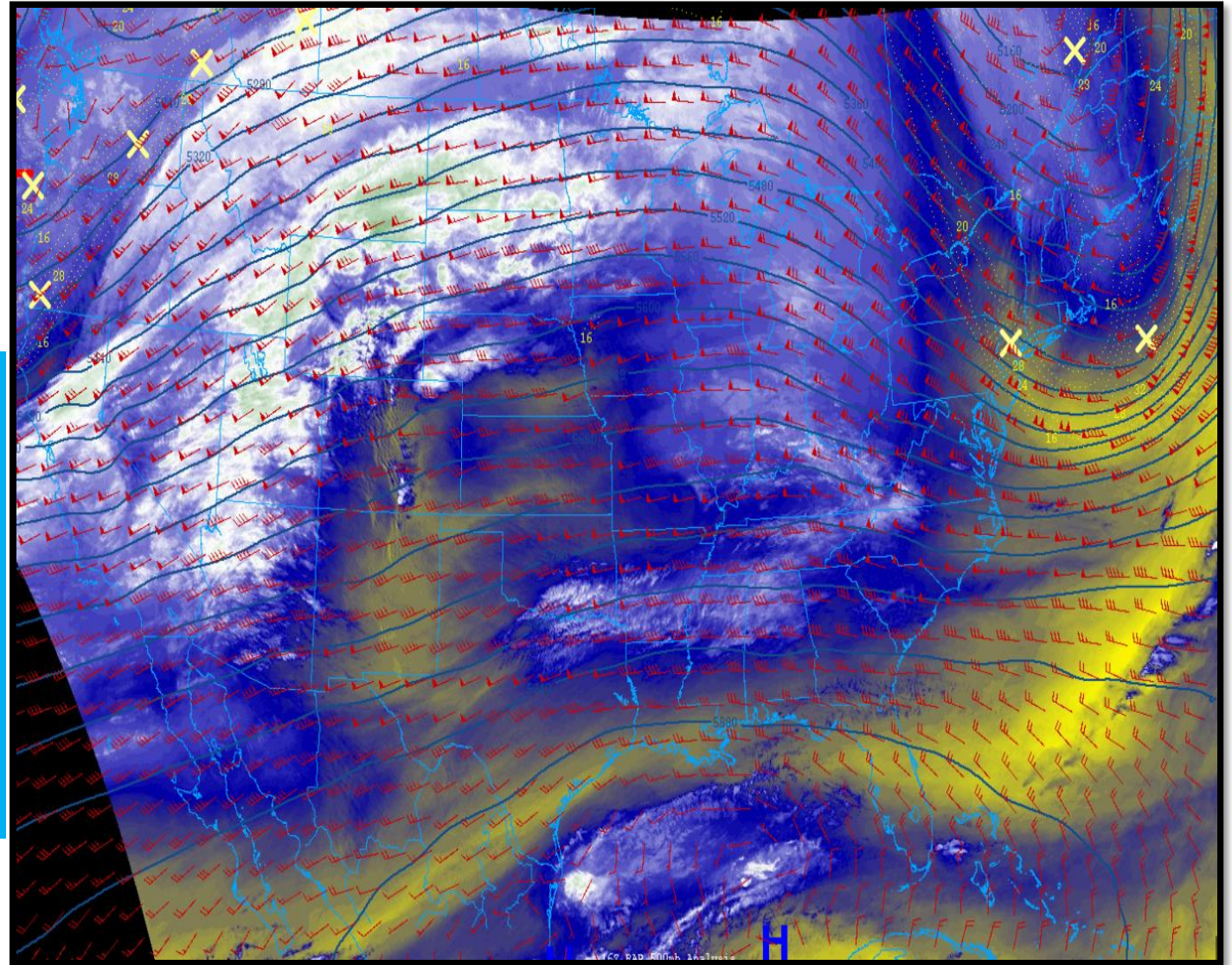


# Upper Level Steering Patterns

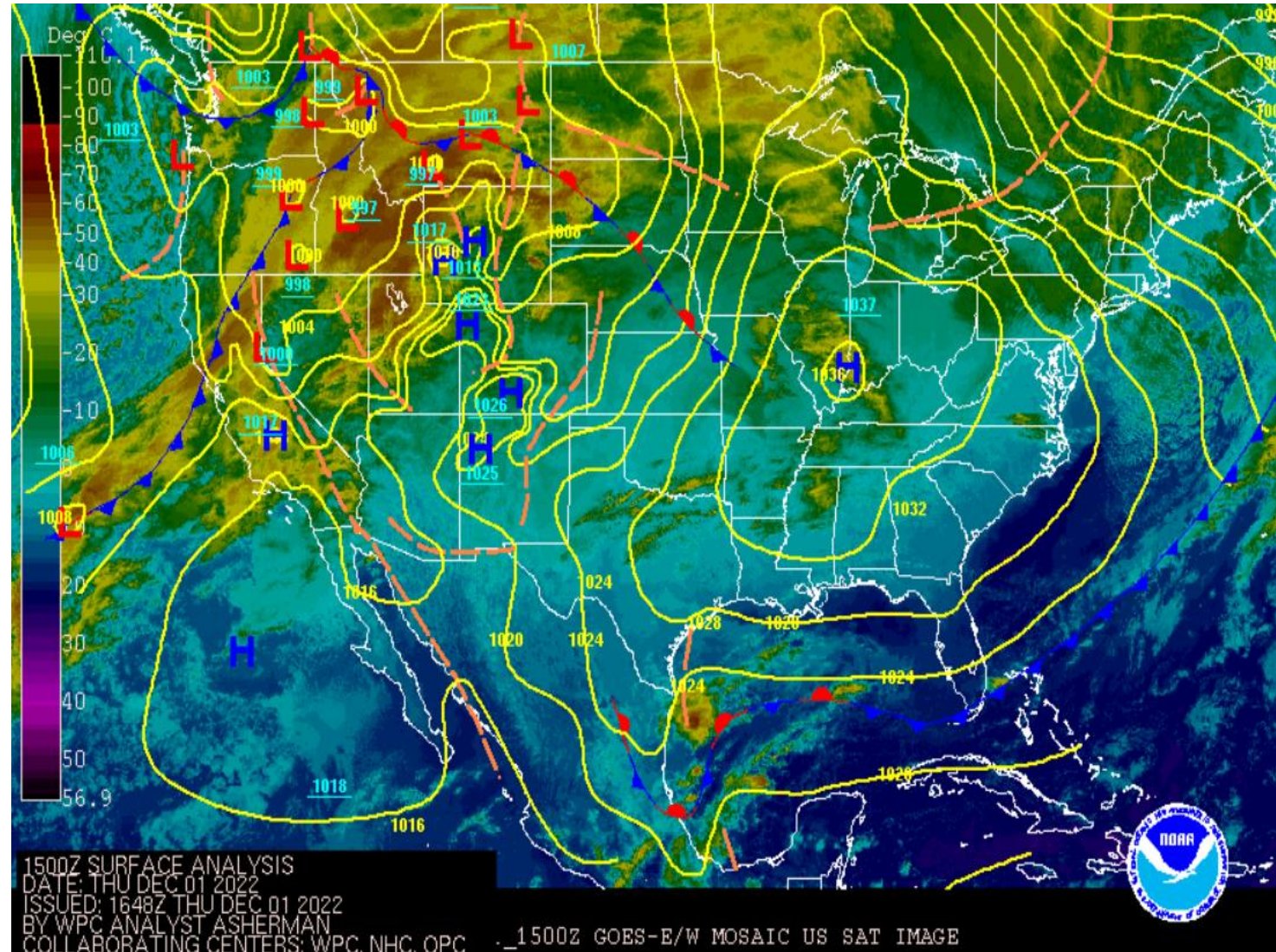


# Surface Weather Map with Fronts

High pressure dominates the eastern states, but this feature will depart the country Friday. This will pull the stalled gulf front back north.



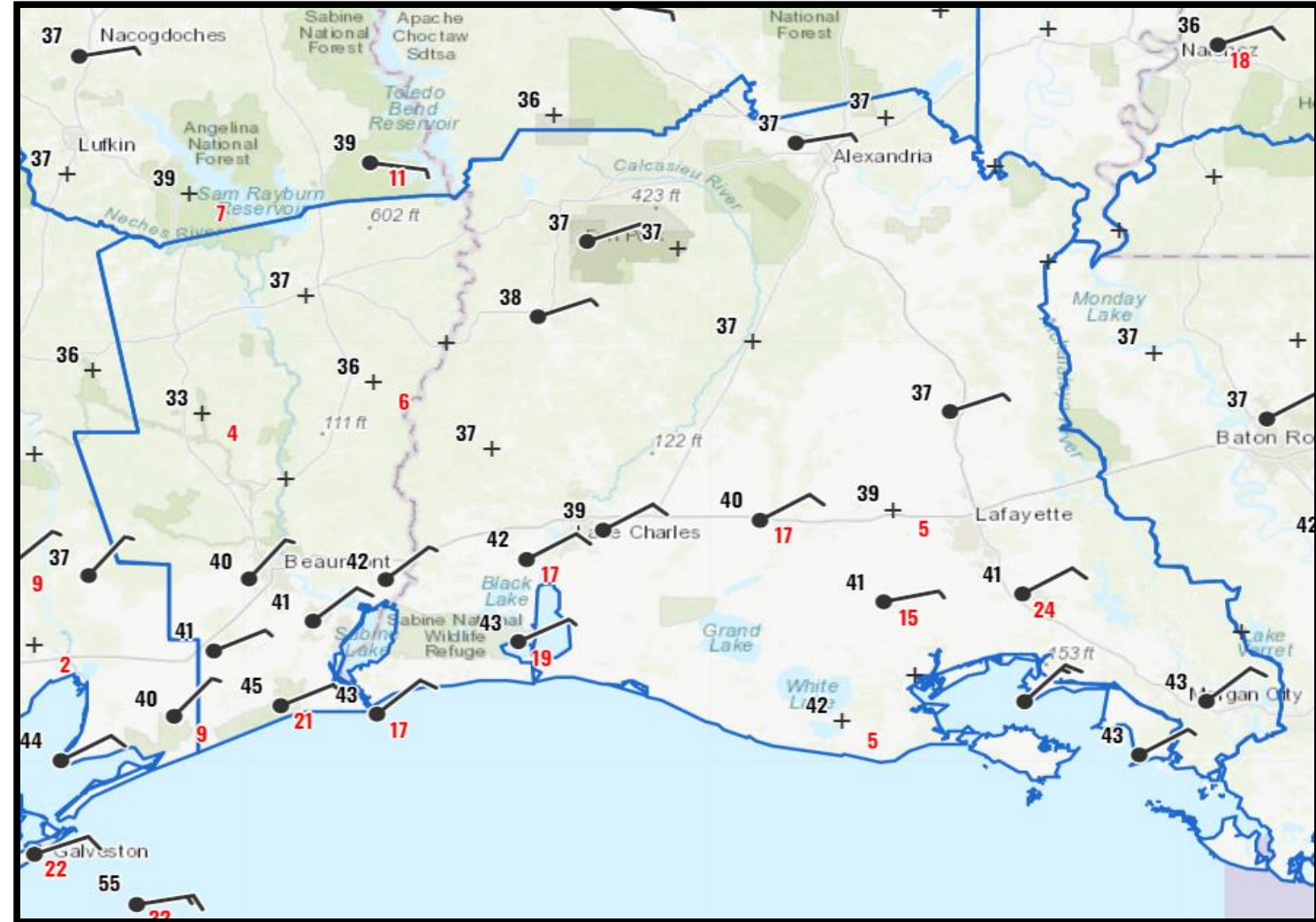


# 6 am Weather Observations



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Under clear skies at 6AM, temperatures were in the upper 30s to low 40s.



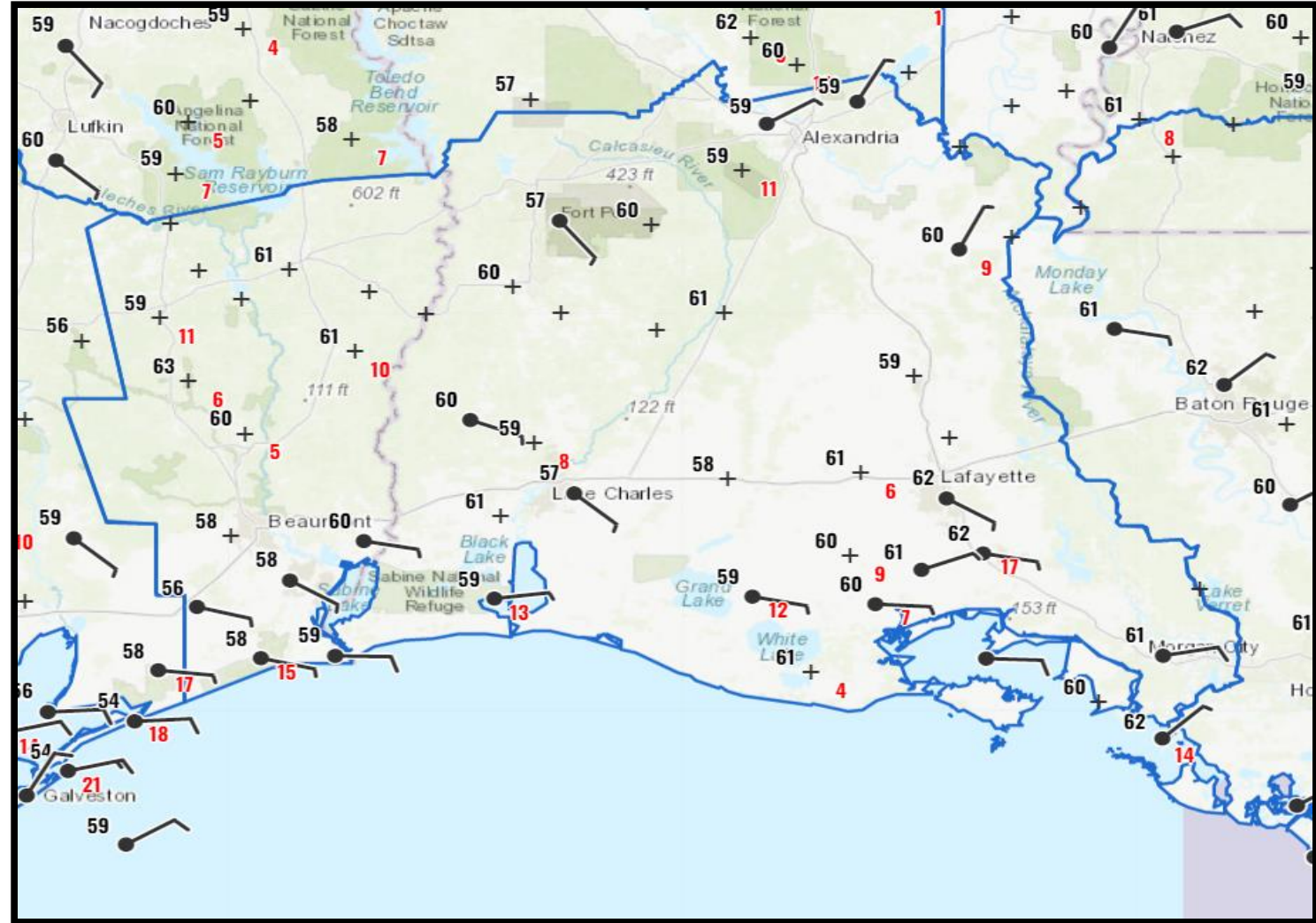


# 2 pm Weather Observations

# Rest of the Day



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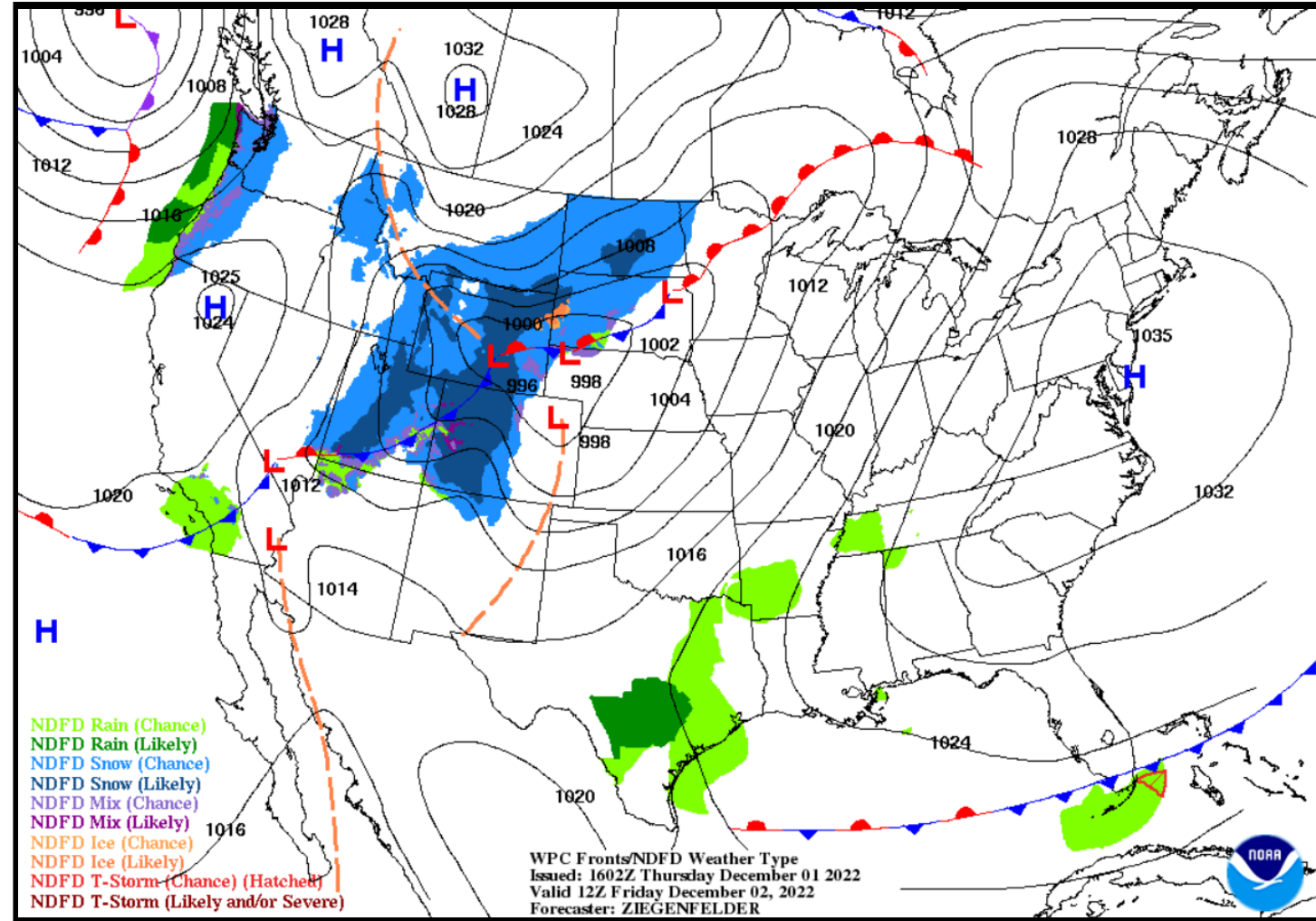
Temperatures and dewpoints will gradually increase into Friday.
