Scattered reports of downed trees and powerlines lead to many power outages across much of the state. The most extensive power outages occurred in the Baltimore area including Carroll, Baltimore, and Anne Arundel Counties. Wet grounds from the recent rains also contributed to the downed trees and branches. 4800 customers were without power during the height of this storm in Montgomery County, MD.
