Weather Summary

A frontal system brought rain to the Eastern US on the 9th and 10th of August. Localized high pressure built in over the Northeast on the 11th as the front moved out to sea. The tail end of the front stalled out over the Southeast during this time, and it eventually drifted northward and developed into a coastal low that produced very heavy rains across DELMARVA. Rainfall totals exceeded 2.00 inches in a few locations which resulted in minor flooding across the Potomac Basin.
