A stationary front lingered across the Mid-Atlantic for the majority of the week. Rain began on the 17th across the southern half of New Jersey. Scattered showers associated with the stagnant system remained over the area through the 19th dumping up to 2.00 inches of rain in an area that had previously flooded no more than ten days prior. The showers stopped on the 21st and for most of the 22nd which allowed for the area's rivers' discharge amounts to drop. Those levels rose again on the 23rd which indicates that an isolated shower or thunderstorm likely added more rain to the Trenton area on late on them 22nd or early on the 23rd which pushed the Assunpink Creek just above minor flood stage.
