About These Maps

The maps are drawn using data from the exceedance probability plots such as the one found here.

The top 3 maps "Percent Chance of Minor/Moderate/Major Flooding" represent the value of the black line (conditional) at each of the thresholds: Minor, Moderate or Major Flood Stage.

The bottom 3 maps "Percent Difference of Reaching Minor/Moderate/Major Flooding Compared to Historical Average" represent how far to the right or left the black line is shifted from the blue line at each of the thresholds: Minor, Moderate or Major Flood Stage.

How are these maps created?

<u>Historical Simulation (blue line)</u>: Model simulation is based on <u>climatological conditions</u> for the 90 day window for each year during the period of record. Climatological "normals"

<u>Conditional Simulation (black line)</u>: Model simulation is based on the present day <u>current model</u> conditions for the 90 day window for each year during the period of record.
