

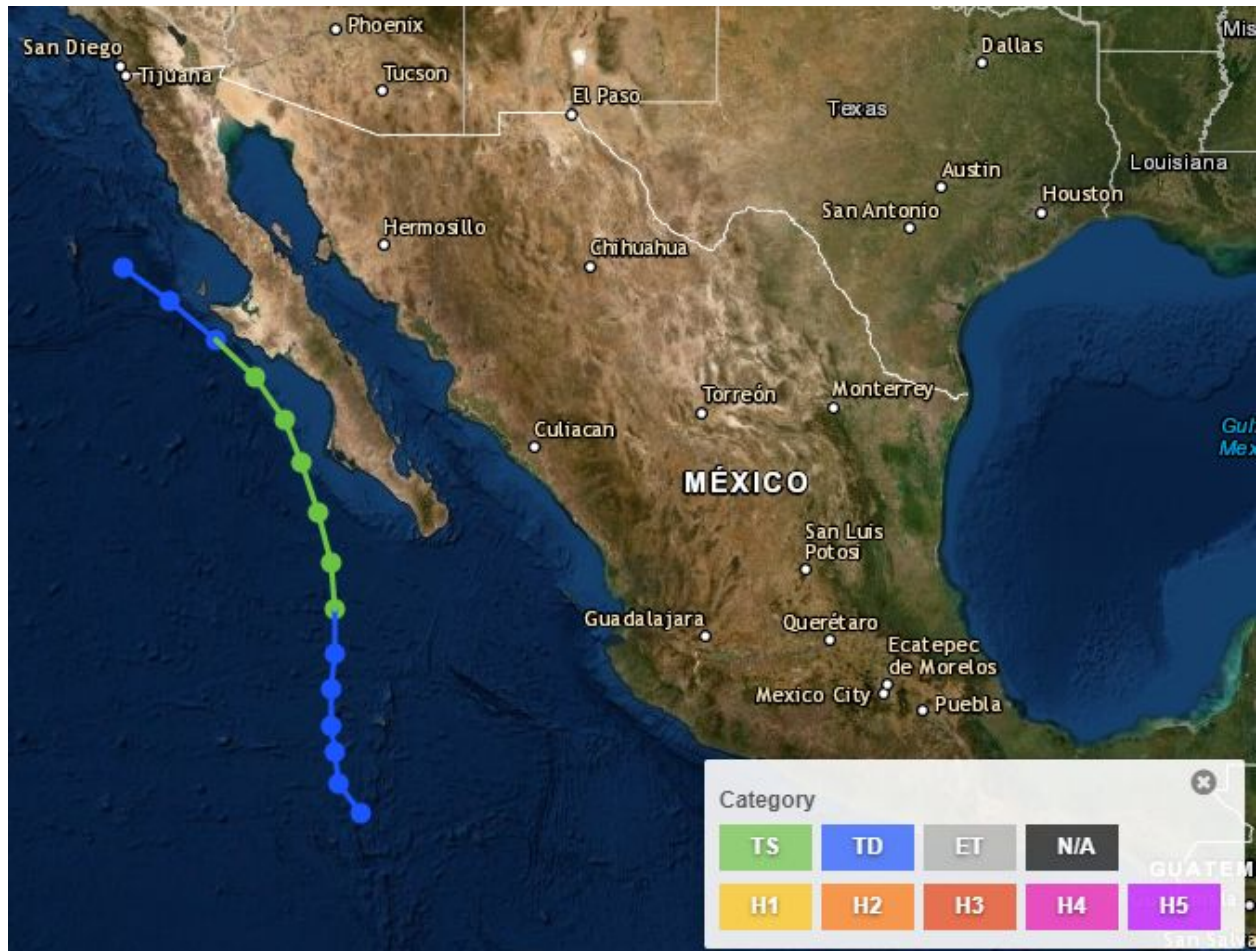
Frank (1998)

Dates: 6-12 Aug 1998

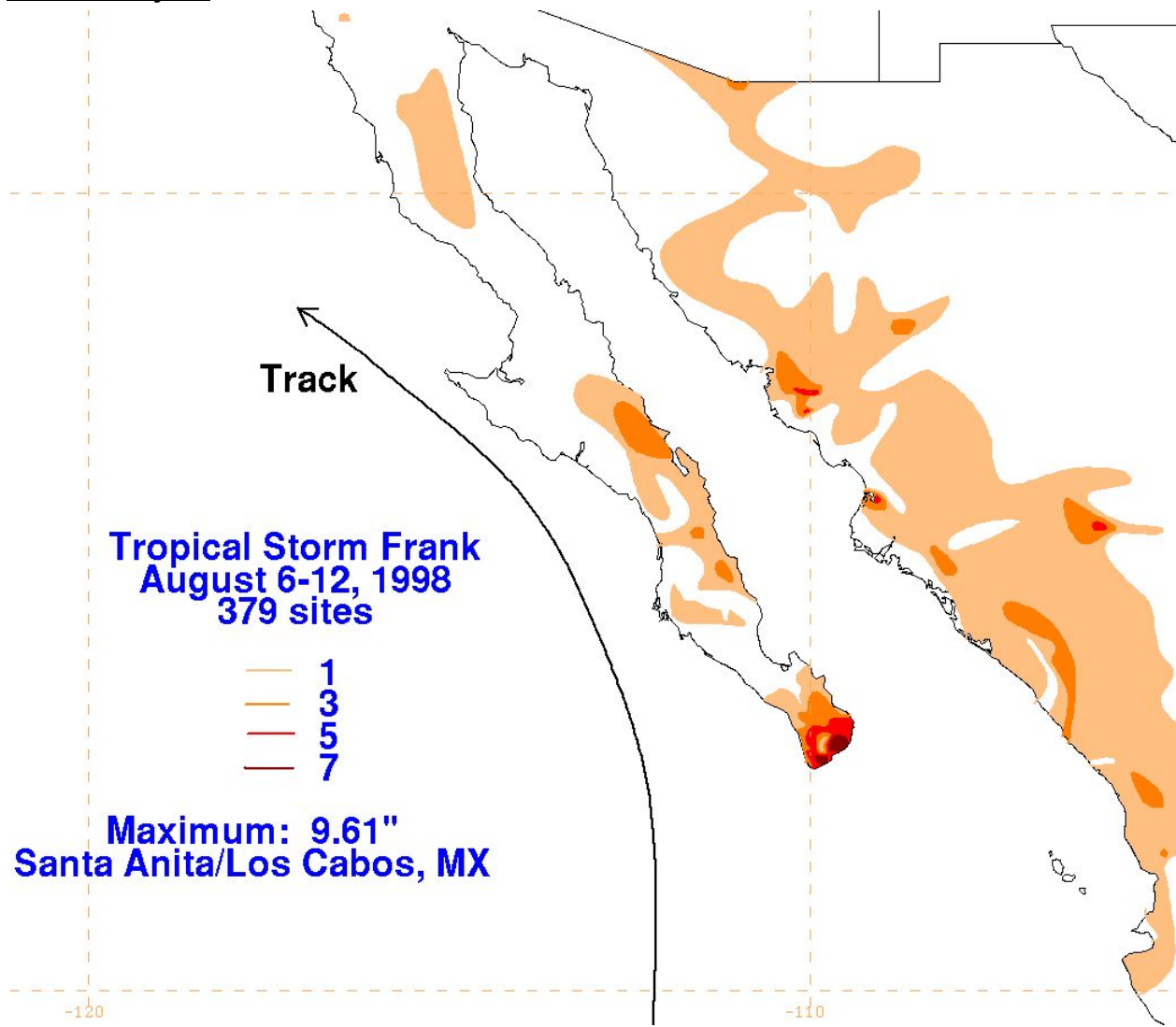
Peak Intensity: Tropical Storm

Tropical Storm Frank (1998) was a weak tropical system that tracked parallel to the west coast of Baja California. As the storm tracked to the northwest, moisture was funneled up the gulf of California and into southern Arizona, providing monsoon like moisture and a remnant low pressure system to initiate storm development.
