

Jimena (2009)

Dates: 28 August – 4 September 2009

Peak Intensity: Cat 4 Hurricane

Hurricane Jimena (2009) was a category two hurricane at landfall on the Baja Peninsula. Hurricane Jimena then crossed into the Gulf of California and quickly dissipated. The remnants of this storm provided tropical moisture to southern Arizona and triggered thunderstorms in the area. Due to the proximity of the system, the moisture entered the area shortly after the hurricane dissipated, with thunderstorms occurring between September 4th and 5th.
