

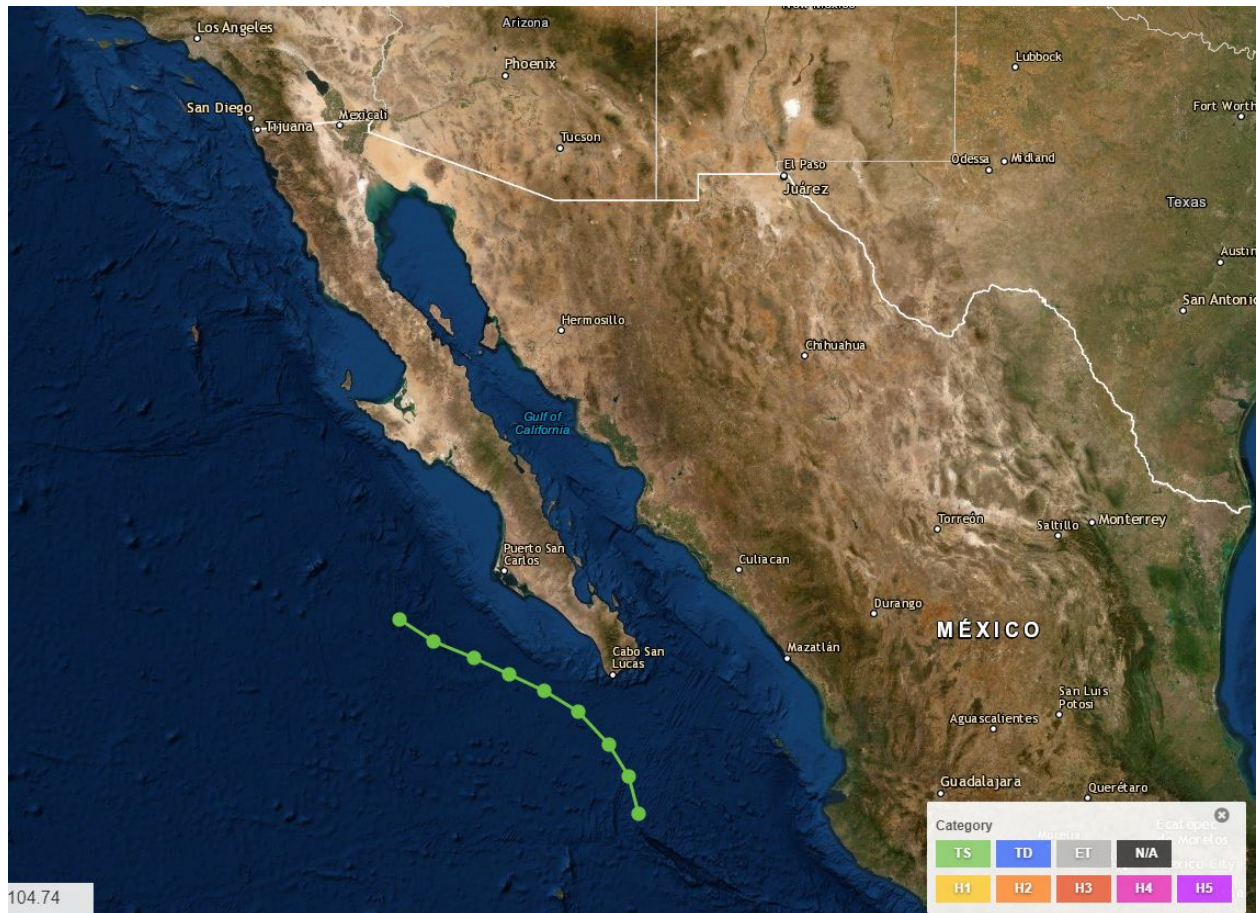
Tillie (1964)

Dates: 7-9 September 1964

Peak Intensity: Tropical Storm

Tropical Storm Tillie (1964) was a short lived tropical system that remained west of Baja California throughout its entire 2 day lifespan. However moisture associated with Tillie was drawn northward into Arizona, resulting in locally heavy rainfall. Tucson recorded 2.85" of rain on Sep 10 which still stands as the wettest September day on record. Other locations across southern Arizona saw upwards of 5" of rainfall.
